song anchor a choice collection of favorites for sabbath school and praise service is a
compilation of hymns intended for use in religious settings this collection originally
published in 1878 offers a glimpse into the musical practices of sabbath schools and
praise services of the late 19th century the selections provide a historical perspective on
the songs and musical styles favored during that era reflecting the devotional and
communal aspects of religious gatherings this volume preserves the melodies and lyrics
that once resonated within congregations offering both a resource for historical research
and a source of inspiration for contemporary audiences interested in the heritage of

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the song anchor for sabbath school and praise service is known as the first seventh day adventist sabbath school songbook compiled in the late 1800 s it was used extensively in sabbath school congregations across the country for years this is a facsimile reprint of the second edition author james edson white was the second son of james and ellen white born into a world of printing edson began his career at the age of 15 working at the review and herald publishing plant in battle creek where he mastered the printing trade after marrying emma mcdearmon edson worked extensively with his brother in law frank belden on compiling and composing hymns for church both edson and frank were musicians and showed talent as composers their work eventually led to the general conference commissioning edson s company j e white publishing company to create a hymnal for church service their work was later published as the original sda hymnal known as hymns and tunes some of the songs in the book include the following above the clouds always be on time a cheerful song always speak the truth blessing by the way behold he cometh coming by and by come to jesus evening prayer father now the day is past god our commander gone to the grave heirs of an immortal crown hark hark my soul infant praises joyful greetings little children like refreshing showers never yield o come let us sing pull for the shore sing praises sabbath welcome the song anchor there is a gate that stand ajar we shall sing white robes

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
