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this is the definitive work on world war ii fighter pilots of the army air force it lists all 80 fighter groups that had pilots who achieved aerial victories the pilots within each group are listed in alphabetical order listing their rank serial number squadron and the number of victories earned while assigned to that squadron the book lists 7 299 pilots who achieved at least a partial victory credit from the air force

this book is the result of nearly six years of research gathering of materials and interviews it presents a chronological listing of the 479th fighter group s activities during the world war ii era from its beginnings until its deactivation based upon a summation of the group s historical records the account also contains personal anecdotes provided by many of the group s former members as well as over 650 photos that serve to illustrate the narration hopefully through the assemblage of this information the memory of the group and the men who comprised the living lifeblood of the 479th fg will be better known and remembered by future generations

the great rat race for europe stories of the 357th fighter group sortie one tells the true stories of the yoxford boys of the 357th fighter group arguably the best army air force fighter group in the european theater during world war two aces kit carson bud anderson johnny england pete peterson chuck yeager and others from this elite group of tigers eventually became famous after the war while other yoxford boys just melted back into the scenery that was the american post war years those were the lucky ones as scores of these brave young american lads flying their p 51 mustangs into combat against the luftwaffe never saw home again as the result of this epic air war over europe their stories are all here including leonard kit carson s account of the great rat race which helped to break the back of the luftwaffe from his fantastic book pursue and destroy the strange and sad end of decorated fighter ace dittie jenkins who safely returned from his last mission against the nazis only to

be killed while celebrating with an impromptu air show over station 373 at leiston and the first hand account of life in a stalag luft prisoner of war camp with colonel henry spicer the irascible commanding officer of the american section of the pow camp and one time 357th fighter group commanding officer who drove the german officers to the brink with his rock solid spirit of rebellion and the love and admiration of his men fly into weather so thick that the ducks are walking with pete peterson one of the leading aces of the group as he walks you through a hair raising landing on leiston field with zero visibility and three inexperienced pilots on his wing then 357th fighter pilot joe shea recaptures the common boredom ridden hours and terror stricken moments faced by replacement pilots of the group during their first combat missions including shea s account of his last encounter eyeball to eyeball with a german pilot in an me 262 jet fighter as it slid over his wing and lined up perfectly in his gun sight relive the greatest as well as the worst days of the 8th air force s first long range mustang fighter outfit in short stories written by the pilots of the 357th fighter group their families and this author in this collection of memories and tall tales of the famous yoxford boys

focusing on the combat operations and daily life of one unit the 9th guards fighter division loza refutes the myth that the p 39 was used mainly as a tank buster or flying artillery instead its primary mission was to protect red army operations from aerial attacks by the enemy so despite the occasional strafing of trains truck convoys and troops most p 39 operations involved attacks on luftwaffe bombers and dogfights with their fighter escorts book jacket

conversino s story is as interesting as it is unfamiliar and succeeds in opening up frantic s many dimensions including the personal as well as the political strategic and operational his revelations regarding the interactions between american servicemen and ukrainian russians are especially valuable and underscore the immense difficulties of implementing alliances at the grass roots level dennis showalter author of tannenberg clash of empires

this study provides an appraisal of germany s air forces from the post world war i era through the early stages of world war ii the author demolishes several myths surrounding the luftwaffe including the belief that they had no ideas beyond the support of ground forces

nicknamed the bluenosed bastards of bodney due to the garish all blue noses of their p 51s the 352nd fg was one of the most successful fighter groups in the eighth air force credited with destroying almost 800 enemy aircraft between 1943 and 1945 the 352nd finished fourth in the ranking of all groups within viii fighter command initially equipped with p 47s the group transitioned to p 51s in the spring of 1944 and it was with the mustang that its pilots enjoyed their greatest success numerous first hand accounts 55 newly commissioned artworks and 140 photos complete this concise history of the bluenosers

adolf galland began world war ii in poland as a lieutenant and squadron commander flying obsolescent biplanes he ended the war as a lieutenant general and was again a squadron commander this time flying me 262 jet fighters in all of aviation history there is no comparable rise and fall by a fighter pilot the most famous german ace and fighter leader of his generation galland s story is simultaneously that of the luftwaffe fighter arm in which he served from foundation to finish fighter general recounts the career of an outstanding combat leader torn from the fighter cockpit to defend his country and sometimes his own pilots in the bizarre bureaucracy of the luftwaffe high command galland s battles against the allied air forces both as a general and in individual combat hold no less drama than his head on battles with goering and hitler galland s triumphs and tragedies his friends and his flames his humor and heartaches pulse anew in fighter general here in this official biography is real life adventure to shame the wildest fiction

based on interviews with the group s survivors and containing numerous photographs this is the first complete history of the unit that included gen claire chennault s famous flying tigers

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
