- 2 Craft Relatable Characters Avoid Stereotypes Embrace characters that are unique and multifaceted Avoid relying on cliches Give Them Distinct Voices Each character should have a unique voice that adds to their personality and adds to the comedic impact Consider A fasttalking nervous character Im telling you its not a prank Its a real monster A slow deliberate character Well I wouldnt say its a monster More like an unusual hairy creature A character with a distinctive accent Ive told ya aint no monster in this here swamp Its just a big ol frog
- 3 Build a Simple but Engaging Plot Clear Conflict Every great sketch has a conflict that drives the story This could be a 2 misunderstanding a wacky situation or a clash of personalities Rising Stakes The conflict should escalate throughout the sketch increasing tension and providing opportunities for laughs Unexpected Twists Keep the audience guessing with surprise twists and turns ensuring the story stays unpredictable
- 4 Master the Art of Pacing FastPaced Dialogue Keep the dialogue quick and snappy using short sentences and punchy lines to maintain a sense of energy Strategic Pauses Use silence effectively for comedic effect A welltimed pause after a funny line can amplify the laughter Vary the Rhythm Avoid monotony Switch between fast and slow moments creating a dynamic listening experience
- 5 Utilize Sound Effects Enhance the Story Sound effects can add layers of humor and realism to your sketch Create Atmosphere Sounds can establish setting mood and context For example a creaking door can heighten suspense or a crashing cymbal can highlight a comedic moment Dont Overuse Keep sound effects purposeful and avoid excessive use that can overwhelm the audience
