coins but you can flip them over one at a time How many flips do you need to guarantee all coins are heads up Answer You only need one flip to guarantee all coins are heads up Heres why If you flip all the coins at once you will reverse the state of each coin If a coin was heads up it will become tails up and vice versa Since you have 10 coins heads up after flipping all of them you will have 10 coins tails up and the rest 90 will be heads up Level 2 Thinking Critically 4 You have two ropes each of which takes exactly one hour to burn completely However the ropes burn unevenly How do you measure 45 minutes using only these two ropes Answer This is a classic ropeburning puzzle Heres the solution Start by lighting both ends of rope 1 and one end of rope 2 simultaneously When rope 1 burns completely after 30 minutes immediately light the other end of rope 2 Rope 2 will now be burning from both ends and will take 15 minutes to burn completely half its remaining time Therefore the total time elapsed will be 30 minutes 15 minutes 45 minutes 5 A farmer has 17 sheep and all but 9 die How many sheep are left Answer This is a bit of a trick question The farmer has 9 sheep left The wording all but 9 means that 9 sheep survived 6 You're driving a bus with 10 passengers At the next stop 3 get off and 5 get on At the 3 following stop 2 get off and 4 get on How old is the bus driver Answer This is another trick question The answer is your age The problem is designed to distract you by focusing on the passengers Level 3 Stepping Up the Complexity 7 You have 100 bottles of wine One bottle is poisoned and will kill anyone who drinks it You have 10 lab rats and one week to determine which bottle is poisoned You can feed the rats from the bottles and after a week you'll know which bottle is poisoned based on which rats die What is the minimum number of rats you need to use to guarantee you can identify the poisoned bottle Answer You need a minimum of 7 rats to identify the poisoned bottle Heres the logic Each rat represents a binary digit 0 or 1 With 7 rats you can create 27 128 unique combinations 0000000 to 1111111 Since you have 100 bottles you have enough combinations to assign a unique pattern of rat feeding to each bottle After a week the pattern of dead rats will correspond to the binary code of the poisoned bottle 8 A man is driving his car down the road He comes to a fork in the road and both paths lead to his destination One path is paved with gold and the other is paved with rocks Which path should he choose Answer The answer lies in the details He should choose the paved road The question focuses on the materials implying there are other factors to consider such as practicality and safety Driving on a goldpaved road would be impractical and potentially dangerous 9 You are in a room with three light switches One of the switches controls a lightbulb in another room You cannot see the lightbulb You can manipulate the switches as you like but you can only go into the other room once How can you determine which switch controls the lightbulb Answer This is a variation on the classic lightbulb puzzle The solution relies on the heat generated by an incandescent bulb Turn switch 1 on and leave it on for a few minutes Turn switch 1 off and turn switch 2 on Enter the room with the lightbulb If the lightbulb is on switch 2 controls it 4 If the lightbulb is off but warm switch 1 controls it If the lightbulb is off and cold switch 3 controls it Level 4 Pushing the Boundaries 10 You have a

3gallon jug and a 5gallon jug You also have an unlimited supply of water How can you measure out exactly 4 gallons of water Answer This is a classic water jug puzzle Heres the solution Fill the 5gallon jug completely Pour water from the 5gallon jug into the 3gallon jug until the 3gallon jug is full You will have 2 gallons remaining in the 5gallon jug Empty the 3gallon jug Pour the 2 gallons from the 5gallon jug into the 3gallon jug Fill the 5gallon jug completely again Carefully pour water from the 5gallon jug into the 3gallon jug which already has 2 gallons in it until the 3gallon jug is full This will use 1 gallon from the 5gallon jug You will now have exactly 4 gallons remaining in the 5gallon jug 11 You are in a room with 100 light bulbs Each bulb has a switch but the switches are not labeled You can turn the switches on and off as you like but you can only enter the room with the lightbulbs once How can you determine which switch controls which lightbulb Answer This is a tricky puzzle that highlights the importance of pattern recognition Turn on the first 10 switches and leave them on for a few minutes Turn off switches 110 and turn on switches 1120 Enter the room with the lightbulbs The first 10 lightbulbs that are on are controlled by switches 110 The next 10 lightbulbs that are on are controlled by switches 1120 The remaining lightbulbs that are off but warm are controlled by switches 2130 You can continue this pattern for the rest of the lightbulbs 12 You have 100 coins laying flat on a table each with a head side and a tail side 10 of them are heads up You cant see the coins but you can flip them over one at a time How many flips do you need to guarantee all coins are heads up Answer You only need one flip to guarantee all coins are heads up Heres why If you flip all the coins at once you will reverse the state of each coin If a coin was heads up it will become tails up and vice versa Since you have 10 coins heads up after flipping all of 5 them you will have 10 coins tails up and the rest 90 will be heads up Level 5 Unconventional Thinking 13 You are in a boat in the middle of a lake You have a rope that is exactly 10 feet long and a rock tied to the end of the rope How can you use the rope and the rock to get to the shore Answer This is a classic lateral thinking puzzle Heres the solution Tie the rock to the rope and throw it as far as you can toward the shore Pull in the rope bringing the boat closer to the shore Repeat this process gradually pulling yourself closer to the shore until you can reach it 14 There are 100 people in a room Each person has a hat placed on their head with the color of the hat randomly assigned Each person can see the hats of everyone else but they cant see their own The rule is that anyone who can correctly deduce the color of their own hat must stand up What happens and why Answer This is a classic logic puzzle that demonstrates the power of deductive reasoning Heres how it plays out If theres only one person in the room and they see that everyone else is wearing a different color hat they know their hat must be the remaining color and will stand up If there are two people in the room and each sees the other person wearing a different color hat theyll both know their hat must be the remaining color and will stand up The logic continues for larger groups If there are 100 people and 99 of them see that everyone else is wearing a different color hat they know their hat must be the remaining color and will stand up Therefore in a room of 100 people all 100 people will

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to succeed in life you must think outside the box this cliché is used to describe creative non standard approaches to problem solving but how does one learn to think outside the box unfortunately there is no simple answer author kiran srinivas believes that you can significantly improve your thinking abilities and this book will force you to think in ways you never have before by sheer practice you can increase your ability to think creatively many of the puzzles in this book will take hours if not days to solve but be encouraged a middle school education is sufficient to answer almost all of the puzzles there are many interview puzzles and if you plan to interview at an investment bank consulting firm high tech firm or in any other related field absorb what brain teasers has to offer as it can be the deciding factor in getting that offer

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
