- 1 Identify Value Start by defining what truly constitutes value from the patients perspective What are their critical needs and expectations Focus on the core services that directly address these needs Example Instead of focusing on the number of patients seen a clinic might prioritize patient satisfaction scores and timely access to specialists
- 2 Map the Value Stream Visually map out the entire process of delivering a specific service from the patients initial contact to their discharge or followup This helps identify bottlenecks and areas of waste Image A simple flowchart depicting a patients journey through a specific healthcare process highlighting potential bottlenecks
