- 1 The Building Blocks of Clarity Grammar Fundamentals Sentences Sentences are the backbone of writing A sentence should express a complete thought containing a subject who or what is performing the action and a verb the action Subjectverb agreement Ensure your subject and verb agree in number For example The cat is sleeping singular subject singular verb and The cats are sleeping plural subject plural verb Word order The standard English sentence order is subjectverbobject While variations exist stick to the standard order for clarity Punctuation Punctuation marks provide structure and rhythm to your writing Full stops periods Mark the end of a sentence Commas Separate items in a list clauses and phrases and indicate pauses Semicolons Join two closely related independent clauses Colons Introduce lists explanations or quotations Pronouns Replace nouns to avoid repetition Pronoun agreement Pronouns must agree with their antecedents the nouns they refer to in gender and number Pronoun reference Pronouns should have clear and unambiguous antecedents Avoid ambiguity especially when using it or this
- 2 The Art of Style Enhancing Your Writing Active voice Use the active voice to make your writing direct and engaging For example 2 The dog chased the ball active is more concise and lively than The ball was chased by the dog passive Conciseness Avoid unnecessary words and phrases Be precise and to the point Eliminate redundancy Avoid saying the same thing twice like extremely unique or completely finished Use strong verbs Choose active descriptive verbs to convey your meaning Variety Use different sentence structures and lengths to keep your writing engaging Figurative language Use metaphors similes and other figurative language to create vivid imagery and enhance your writing However use them sparingly and with care
- 3 Mastering the Rules Common Grammar Mistakes Dangling modifiers Phrases that modify a word not clearly stated in
