their multiculturalism and their belief in the equivalence of all cultures and religions to meet the challenge from islam christians need to know more about the important differences between islam and christianity yet many have been lulled into complacency by the misleading and largely unexamined assumption that the two religions are similar the time that christians spend in pursuing common ground is time that islamic activists will use to press their radical agenda in addition to challenging both the multicultural and common ground approaches william kilpatrick also exposes the role played by atheists and secularists in advancing islam despite paying lip service to freedom radical secularists serve as enablers of radical islam the civil liberties that the west enjoys are the fruit of christian civilization kilpatrick argues and only a reawakened christianity can defend them against islam s advance
