imagining the pagan past explores stories of britain s pagan history these tales have been characterised by gods and fairies folklore and magic they have had an uncomfortable relationship with the scholarly world often being seen as historically dubious self indulgent romance and worse encouraging tribal and nationalistic feelings or challenging church and state this book shows how important these stories are to the history of british culture taking the reader on a lively tour from prehistory to the present from the middle ages to the twenty first century marion

gibson explores the ways in which british pagan gods and goddesses have been represented in poetry novels plays chronicles scientific and scholarly writing from geoffrey of monmouth to edmund spenser william shakespeare to seamus heaney and h g wells to naomi mitchison it explores romano british celtic and anglo saxon deities and fictions the result is a comprehensive picture of the ways in which writers have peopled the british pagan pantheons throughout history imagining the pagan past will be essential reading for all those interested in the history of paganism

this work is valuable as history containing as it does contemporary information on the period after 278 a d it was used widely during the middle ages and the existence today of nearly 200 manuscript copies is evidence of its past popularity

this is the second and extensively revised edition of the first full scale scholarly study of what is arguably the only fully formed religion that england has ever given the world that of modern pagan witchcraft which has now spread from english shores across four continents ronald hutton examines the nature of that religion and its development and offers a history of attitudes to witchcraft paganism and magic in british society since 1800 its pages reveal village cunning folk victorian ritual magicians classicists and archaeologists leaders of woodcraft and scouting movements freemasons and members of rural secret societies we also find some of the leading figures of english literature from the romantic poets to w b yeats d h lawrence and robert graves as well as the main personalities who have represented pagan witchcraft to the public world since 1950 thriller writers like dennis wheatley and films and television programmes get similar coverage as does tabloid journalism the material is by its very nature often sensational and care is taken throughout to distinguish fact from fantasy in a manner not hitherto applied to most

of the stories involved consistently densely researched triumph of the moon presents an authoritative insight into an aspect of modern cultural history which has attracted sensational publicity but has hitherto been little understood this edition incorporates all of the new research carried out into the subject by the author and by others who have often been inspired by this book during the twenty years since it was first published

even in pagan antiquity there were those who while participating in the community's religious life did not believe in literal gods in the centuries that followed the christian domination of the west the epithet godless pagan was leveled at a wide variety of people in the 1960s there emerged a community of people who sought to reclaim the name pagan from its history of opprobrium these neo pagans were interested in nature spirituality and polytheism and identified with the misunderstood and persecuted pagans of antiquity while many pagans today believe in literal gods there are a growing number of pagans who are godless today the diverse assemblage of spiritual paths known as paganism includes atheist pagans or atheopagans humanistic and naturalistic pagans buddho pagans animists pantheists gaians and other non theistic pagans here their voices are gathered together to share what it means to be pagan and godless

many observers greeted the second vatican council 1962-65 as the most important religious event in the twentieth century its implementation and impact are still being felt in the catholic church the wider christian world and beyond one sea change that vatican ii brought concerned roman catholic attitudes towards judaism islam and other religions gerald o collins breaks fresh ground by examining in detail five documents from the council which embodied a new mindset about other religious faiths and mandated changes that quickly led to international and national dialogues between the catholic church and the followers of non christian religions the book also includes

chapters on the insights that prepared the way for the rethinking expressed by vatican ii and on the follow up to the council s teaching found in the work of pope john paul ii and jacques dupuis o collins ably illustrates how the council made a startling advance in official catholic teaching about followers of other living faiths carefully researched the book is written in the clear accessible style that readers of previous works by o collins will recognize
