there is a need to refine our current psychiatric nosology to produce diagnostic criteria and disorder categories that keep pace with advances in neuroscience while at the same time enhance clinical utility furthermore dimensional aspects of psychiatric disorders require greater recognition so as to improve our understanding of boundaries between disorders and underscore the heterogeneous nature of psychopathology the conceptual evolution of dsm 5 provides a framework for the evolution of the forthcoming diagnostic system in the fifth edition of diagnostic and statistical manual of mental disorders dsm 5 which will help advance clinical practice and facilitate ongoing development of diagnostic criteria this manual highlights recent progress in our understanding of cross cutting factors relevant to psychiatric diagnosis and symptom presentation includes detailed discussions on the role of factors such as age gender culture and disability in the expression of mental disorders provides a review of genetic evidence supporting a cross cutting approach to nosology offers suggestions for integrating cross cutting factors with dsm 5 the conceptual evolution of dsm 5 was written to impart a theoretical context for understanding potential revisions to dsm 5 the authors reevaluate the structure of the current manual and discuss cross cutting approaches to facilitate clinical practice and refine research approaches that will guide clinical trials genetics imaging and treatment guidelines the authors provide the following insights detailed descriptions of age gender and culture specific aspects relevant to psychiatric diagnosis and the need for sensitivity to these factors when making diagnoses discussions on the dimensional aspects of mental disorders including overlapping symptoms relevant to many or most diagnoses consideration of alternative classifications of disorders that recognize disorders sharing validating features presentation of neuroscientific and epidemiologic

evidence to expand understanding of disorders beyond that of the categorical organization presented in dsm iv a review of clinical implications including how clinicians may shift their conceptualization of previously reified diagnostic criteria and their consequences as presented to the 99th annual meeting of the american psychopathological association the conceptual evolution of dsm 5 explores the rapidly changing research base for the understanding of neurodevelopmental neurocognitive addictive and other psychiatric disorders the contributions in this volume confirm that dsm 5 is intended to be a living document that can accommodate revisions to specific diagnostic areas based on new evidence that is replicable and subject to review this efficient updating process will help researchers and clinicians keep abreast of the latest protocols for the research diagnosis and treatment of mental illness

in 2013 the american psychiatric association published the 5th edition of its diagnostic and statistical manual of mental disorders dsm 5 often referred to as the bible of psychiatry the manual only classifies mental disorders and does not explain them or guide their treatment while science should be the basis of any diagnostic system to date there is no knowledge on whether most conditions listed in the manual are true diseases moreover in dsm 5 the overall definition of mental disorder is weak failing to distinguish psychopathology from normality in spite of all the progress that has been made in neuroscience over the last few decades the psychiatric community is no closer to understanding the etiology and pathogenesis of mental disorders than it was fifty years ago in making the dsm 5 prominent experts delve into the debate about psychiatric nosology and examine the conceptual and pragmatic issues underlying the new manual while retracing the historic controversy over dsm considering the political context and economic impact of the manual and focusing on what was revised or left unchanged in the new edition this timely volume addresses the main concerns of the future of psychiatry and questions whether the dsm legacy can truly improve the specialty and advance its goals

this book critically evaluates the fifth edition of the diagnostic and statistical manual of mental disorders dsm 5 through analysis of the history of psychiatric diagnosis and of the handbook itself it argues that the dsm 5 has a narrow biomedical approach to mental disorders and proposes a new contextualizing model of mental health symptoms

system and education this approach facilitates the continued development of a research base in community health and promotes the establishment of programs for monitoring treating and preventing mental illness addresses many fascinating and clinically relevant issues such as those raised by the concept and the definition of mental disorders and how these impact psychiatric services and practice by individual providers this collection should prove useful to the advisory groups task forces and working groups for the revision of these two classifications as well as for researchers in the area of diagnosis and classification and more generally in public health

this readable guide to the assessment and management of patients with bipolar disorder can help physicians keep abreast of dramatic and rapid advances of recent years and integrate them into their practice handbook of diagnosis and treatment of bipolar disorders emphasizes recent controlled studies and fda approved indications and translates these data into the real world of clinical practice the contributions of the eleven chapter authors from stanford university reflect more than a decade of clinical research and treatment undertaken at that institution including advances in diagnosis and interventions supported by controlled studies they provide crucial information regarding diagnosis pharmacotherapy psychotherapy and treatment of patients from special populations such as children women and older adults and patients with particular challenging illness course such as rapid cycling this is the first book to provide quantitative assessment of potential benefit number needed to treat and risk number needed to harm for all approved treatments for bipolar disorder providing clinicians with information needed to balance benefits and risks in order to render individualized state of the art evidence based care it describes all fda approved indications reviewing efficacy safety tolerability pharmacokinetics illness phase specific dosing and drug interactions a chapter on multiphase treatment strategy explains crucial illness transition points and describes how these have been integrated with knowledge of illness phase in mood disorders the book then demonstrates the relevance of this approach to therapeutics by providing an overview of pharmacotherapy that covers the emergence of evidence based pharmacotherapy and number needed to treat and harm analyses guidelines to managing acute manic and mixed episodes that include evidence based assessments of lithium divalproex carbamazepine and second generation antipsychotics coverage of acute major depressive episodes in bipolar disorders that outlines four tiers of treatment for this most pervasive illness phase with the fewest approved treatments discussion of the longer term management of bipolar disorders including reviews of controlled trials of recently approved pharmacotherapies such as lamotrigine olanzapine aripiprazole and adjunctive quetiapine a review of the use of mood stabilizers and second generation antipsychotics often in combinations as well as the controversial role of adjunctive antidepressants in treating patients with rapid cycling bipolar disorders description of important advances in evidence based adjunctive psychotherapeutic interventions in bipolar depression and bipolar maintenance treatment comprehensive in scope yet readily accessible for application to clinical practice the book includes summary tables quick reference lists of clinical pearls and case studies to make its content more relevant handbook of diagnosis and treatment of bipolar disorders is the ideal source for integrating recent research into everyday practice

since its third edition in 1980 the diagnostic and statistical manual of mental disorders dsm of the american psychiatric association has acquired a hegemonic role in the health care professions and has had a broad impact on the lay public the publication in may 2013 of its fifth edition the dsm 5 marked the latest milestone in the history of the dsm and of american psychiatry in the dsm 5 in perspective philosophical reflections on the psychiatric babel experts in the philosophy of psychiatry propose original essays that explore the main issues related to the dsm 5 such as the still weak validity and reliability of the classification the scientific status of its revision process the several cultural gender and sexist biases that are apparent in the criteria the comorbidity issue and the categorical vs dimensional debate for several decades the dsm has been nicknamed the psychiatric bible this volume would like to suggest another biblical metaphor the tower of babel altogether the essays in this volume describe the dsm as an imperfect and unachievable monument a monument that was originally built to celebrate the new unity of clinical psychiatric discourse but that ended up creating as a result of its hubris ever more profound practical divisions and theoretical difficulties

recent developments in the conceptualization of externalizing spectrum disorders including attention deficit hyperactivity disorder conduct disorder antisocial personality disorder and substance use disorders suggest common genetic and neural substrates despite this neither shared vulnerabilities nor their implications for developmental models of externalizing conduct are captured by prevailing nosologic and diagnostic systems such as the dsm 5 the oxford handbook of externalizing spectrum disorders is the first book of its kind to capture the developmental psychopathology of externalizing spectrum disorders by examining causal factors across levels of analysis and developmental epochs while departing from the categorical perspective world renowned experts on externalizing psychopathology demonstrate how shared genetic and neural vulnerabilities predispose to trait impulsivity a highly heritable personality construct that is often shaped by adverse environments into increasingly intractable forms of externalizing conduct across development consistent with contemporary models of almost all forms of psychopathology the handbook emphasizes the importance of neurobiological vulnerability and environmental risk interactions in the expression of externalizing behavior across the lifespan the volume concludes with an integrative ontogenic process

model of externalizing psychopathology in which diverse equifinal and multifinal pathways to disorder are specified

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
