the narrator's efforts to influence first time readers experience of the narrative as they proceed sequentially through the text he traces John's characterization as forerunner from a glowing introduction in ch 3 albeit with a slight flaw in his ideological point of view on Jesus through a progressive exacerbation of this flaw to a rehabilitation of John in ch 11 as a result of this rehabilitation the narrator is able to continue to use John in his role as forerunner in the second half of the narrative even after John's death has removed him from the story line
