aid to developing countries started well before world war ii but was undertaken as an ad hoc activity or was delivered by private organizations this changed after the war in his inaugural address in 1949 the american president harry truman announced a bold new programme for making the benefits of our scientific advances and industrial progress available for the improvement and growth of underdeveloped nations the so called point iv plan at that time it was thought that this support would be needed only for a limited

number of years comparable to the marshall plan assistance to europe but reality proved to be different providing aid was a very long term affair since the fifties the aid provided has changed at different occasions in the beginning aid concentrated on constructing infrastructure such as roads railways dams and harbours in order to promote industrial development in the sixties aid to agriculture was added and in the seventies aid to social sectors basic needs was also provided the eighties brought worldwide debt problems major donors applied structural adjustment policies some called this the lost decade *década perdida* the nineties saw the arrival of the first environmental considerations and asked for attention for the role of women and good governance the form of aid changed from projects to programmes and budget support describing the different aid forms of the last 65 years and analysing why aid changed from time to time are the subjects of this book professionals and students in the area of international cooperation will benefit from studying this history as at this moment old concepts are reappearing or applied by new donors like china is the pendulum really swinging back as louis emmerij at one point suggested

what is the role of elites in shaping foreign policy did unaccountable foreign policy elites shape the post 1945 world order chatham house and the council on foreign relations were vital in america s shift from isolationism to globalism and in britain s shift from empire to its current pro american orientation and were also fundamental in engineering public backing for a new world order inderjeet parmar presents new evidence to show how well organized and well connected elite think tanks helped to change the world

how a field built on the intellectual labor and expertise of women erased them the academic field of international relations presents its own history as largely a project of elite white men and yet women played a prominent role in the creation of this new cross disciplinary field in erased patricia owens shows that since its beginnings in the early twentieth century international relations relied on the intellectual labour of women and their expertise on such subjects as empire and colonial administration anticolonial organising non western powers and international organisations indeed women were among the leading international thinkers of the era shaping the development of the field as scholars journalists and public intellectuals and as heterosexual spouses and intimate same sex partners drawing on a wide range of archival sources and weaving together personal institutional and intellectual narratives owens documents key moments and locations in the effort to forge international relations as a separate academic discipline in britain she finds that women s ideas and influence were first marginalised and later devalued ignored and erased examining the roles played by some of the most important women thinkers in the field including margery perham merze tate eileen power margaret cleve coral bell and susan strange owens traces the intellectual and institutional legacies of misogyny and racism she argues that the creation of international relations was a highly gendered and racialised project that failed to understand plurality on a worldwide scale acknowledging this intellectual failure and recovering the history of women in the field points to possible sources for its renewal

history at war is a unique book it throws light on important unexplored aspects of the pursuit of historical truth it tells how alone among historians noble frankland fought in the bomber offensive during the second world war and then together with sir charles webster wrote its official history how he transformed the imperial war museum from a dying institution into one of the world s leading historical centres for the study of the conflicts of the twentieth century how he played a major part in television documentary productions including in particular the world at war and how he wrote a series of original rigorously researched historical works in history at war he describes the battles he had to fight against the mandarins and media merchants who sought to impose a spin on history to suit their own ends and were ruthless and unscrupulous in their methods its meticulous documentation gives a guarantee of authenticity to his staggering account of how those in high places tried to distort history which might otherwise seem scarcely credible the

they have often worked at cross purposes by fragmenting policy and constraining the education process at schools with the greatest needs wong s examination is shaped by several questions how do these rules come about what role does politics play in retention of the rules do the federal state and local governments espouse different policies in what ways do these policies operate at cross purposes how do they affect educational opportunities do the policies cohere in ways that promote better and more equitable student outcomes wong concludes that the five types of entrenched rules for resource allocation are rooted in existing governance arrangements and seemingly impervious to partisan shifts interest group pressures and constitutional challenge and because these rules foster policy fragmentation and embody initiatives out of step with the performance based reform agenda of the 1990s the outlook for positive change in public education is uncertain unless fairly radical approaches are employed wong also analyzes four allocative reform models two based on the assumption that existing political structures are unlikely to change and two that seek to empower actors at the school level the two models for systemwide restructuring aimed at intergovernmental coordination and or integrated governance would seek to clarify responsibilities for public education among federal state and local authorities above all integrating political and educational accountability the other two models identified by wong shift control from state and district to the school one based on local leadership and the other based on market forces in discussing the guiding principles of the four models wong takes care to identify both the potential and limitations of each written with a broad policy audience in mind wong s book should appeal to professionals interested in the politics of educational reform and to teachers of courses dealing with educational policy and administration and intergovernmental relations
