moviemakers at work from the 1950s during the studios decline to today s hollywood directors producers writers actors cinematographers composers film editors and independent filmmakers appear within these pages including steven spielberg nora ephron george lucas sidney poitier meryl streep david lynch darren aronofsky and more we see how the filmmakers of today and those of hollywood s golden age face the same challenges of both art and craft to tell compelling stories on the screen and we see the ways in which actors and directors work together how each director has his or her own approach and how they share techniques and theories

contains interviews with 24 filmmakers assembled from american film institute seminars conducted since 1967 guided by the attitude that filmmaking is a collaborative process this compilation reflects a trend in recent years to go beyond the preoccupation with directors includes actors cinematographers production designers composers editors agents producers and screenwriters from lucille ball to richard zanuck each interview is preceded by a brief biographical sketch and a selected filmography

this book examines the role that the american film institute afi had in supporting experimental and independent cinema at a key moment of change in the history of american film weaving a rich historical narrative ramirez argues that the cold war struggle for cultural supremacy motivated the creation of the federally funded afi exploring the intersection of business interests and political objectives ramirez demonstrates how the afi s approach to experimental and independent cinema was marked by an interest in promoting innovative aesthetics and protecting the creative freedom of filmmakers but lacked the attention to distribution and exhibition that would strengthen the viability of experimental and independent filmmaking as professional practices scholars of film history and american studies will find this work particularly useful

after more than fifteen years this initial volume of the american film institute catalog series is again in print the 1920s set covers the important filmmaking period when movies became talkies and the careers of many influential directors and actors were launched films such as wings the phantom of the opera all quiet on the western front and the jazz singer are included in this volume

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
