the perfect introduction to bluegrass and traditional fiddle tunes sections include fiddle tunes hornpipes waltzes jigs strathspeys reels and improvisation the 43 traditional fiddle standards covered in the book comprise the core fiddle tune repertoire all songs are demonstrated on the included cd each song is taught in a basic standard arrangement and then in an advanced variation

this book presents standard fiddle tunes in basic form then shows you how on a phrase by phrase basis the tunes can become vehicles for your own improvisations it is designed to open the door to creating spontaneous variations or improvisations based on the melodic structure unique to each tune each tune in the book is presented first in its basic form then with four variations the variations are printed directly beneath the melody with the corresponding measures aligned so that you can easily compare them to the original melody and to each other the accompanying cd features mandolin and rhythm guitar on separate channels so you can turn off the lead and play along with the rhythm or vice versa intermediate in difficulty

this book contains a selection of fiddle tunes arranged for the beginning cello player the idea is to supply a sampling of melodies that will give almost instant gratification to the novice one of the drawbacks of the classic way of teaching cello is the boredom of some of the early pedagogic repertoire this book is meant to be an antidote to that tedium fiddle tunes are great ways to become accustomed to typical manipulations of major scales and to introduce the sound of arpeggios the only technical requisite for the music is the ability to play a major scale of some sort the tunes were chosen for their fun melodic content while demonstrating some typical aspects of fiddling they are grouped by key with a couple of exceptions and roughly arranged in order of difficulty within each key group the included split track cd demonstrates many of the tunes with guitar accompaniment and will help teach the swing phrasing

this book and online audio recordings s intended to be a tune repertoire book it includes over 100 old time festival favorites some are cliche others unusual some easy some difficult this mandolin book includes two lines of standard notation basic and advanced as well as a mandolin tab line that can beinterpreted for fiddle also the basic version should
