imagine an america where politicians governmental institutions schools new technologies and interest groups work together to promote informed engaged citizens civic education in the twenty first century brings together scholars from various disciplines to show how such a united states is possible today inspired by alexis de toqueville s analysis of american democracy in the early 1800s this edited volume represents a multidimensional evaluation of civic education in its new and varied forms while some lament a civics crisis in america today civic education in the twenty first century raises hope that we can have an informed and active citizenry we find the activities of a number of politicians government institutions schools and interest groups as promising developments in the struggle to educate and engage americans in their democracy new technologies and new innovations in civic education have laid the foundation for a revitalized american civic ecology with civic education in the twenty first century we call for the united states to make these practices less isolated

and more common throughout the country the volume is broken into three major sections first there are four chapters exploring the history and philosophical debates about civic education particularly with respect to its role in america s educational institutions then the second section provides seven groundbreaking inquiries into how politicians and political institutions can promote civic education and engagement through their routine operations as some examples this section explores how politicians through campaigns and judiciaries through community programs enhance civic knowledge and encourage civic engagement this section also explores how new technologies like the internet and social media are increasingly used by government institutions and other entities to encourage a more politically informed and engaged citizenry finally the third section contains six chapters that explore programs and practices in higher education that are enhancing civic education engagement and our knowledge of them from the virtual civics campus of fort hayes state to citizens academies throughout the country this section shows the possibilities for schools today to once again be civics actors and promoters

by nearly every measure americans are less engaged in their communities and political activity than generations past so write the editors of this volume who survey the current practices and history of citizenship education in the united states they argue that the current period of creative destruction when schools are closing and opening in response to reform mandates is an ideal time to take an in depth look at how successful strategies and programs promote civic education and good citizenship making civics count offers research based insights into what diverse students and teachers know and do as civic actors and proposes a blueprint for civic education for a new generation that is both practical and visionary

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in recent years a conservative majority of the u s supreme court over vigorous dissents has developed circumventions to the establishment clause of the first amendment that allow state legislatures unabashedly to use public tax dollars increasingly to aid private elementary and secondary education this expansive and innovative legislation provides considerable governmental funds to support parochial schools and other religiously affiliated education providers that political response to the perceived declining quality of traditional public schools and the vigorous school choice movement for alternative educational opportunities provokes passionate constitutional controversy yet the court s recent decision in arizona christian school tuition organization v winn inappropriately denies taxpayers recourse to challenge these proliferating tax funding schemes in federal courts professors winer and crimm clearly elucidate the complex and controversial policy legal and constitutional issues involved in using tax expenditures mechanisms such as exclusions deductions and credits that economically function as government subsidies to finance private religious schooling the authors argue that legislatures must take great care in structuring such programs and set forth various proposals to ameliorate the highly troubling dissention and divisiveness generated by state aid for religious education

the plot to change america exposes the myths that help identity politics perpetuate itself this book reveals what has really happened explains why it is urgent to change course and offers a strategy to do so though we should not fool ourselves into thinking that it will be easy to eliminate identity politics we should not overthink it either identity politics relies on the creation of groups and then on giving people incentives to adhere to them if we eliminate group making and the enticements we can get rid of identity politics the first myth that this book exposes is that identity politics is a grassroots movement when from the beginning it has been and continues to be an elite project for too long we have lived with the fairy tale that america has organically grown into a nation gripped by victimhood and identitarian division that it is all the result of legitimate demands by minorities for recognition or restitutions for past wrongs the second myth is that identity politics is a response to the demographic change this country has undergone since immigration laws were radically changed in 1965 another myth we are told is that to fight these changes is as depraved as it is

futile since by 2040 america will be a minority majority country anyway this book helps to explain that none of these things are necessarily true
