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the american independent sector has attracted much attention in recent years an upsurge

of academic work on the subject being accompanied by wider public debate but many questions remain about how exactly independence should be defined and how its relationship might be understood with other parts of the cinematic landscape most notably the hollywood studios edited and written by leading authors in the field american independent cinema indie indiewood and beyond offers an examination of the field through four sections that range in focus from broad definitions to close focus on particular manifestations of independence a wide variety of examples are included but within a framework that offers insights into how these are related to one another more specifically this collection offers an account of recent developments as well as reviewing reassessing and revising a number of central positions approaches and arguments relating to various parts of the independent and or indie sector individual case studies that range from the distinctive qualities of the work of established quality filmmakers such as wes anderson steven soderbergh and rebecca miller to studies of horror genre production at the more disreputable end of the independent spectrum examples of the limits of independence available in some cases within hollywood including studies of the work of stanley kubrick and hal ashby case studies of under researched areas in the margins of american independent cinema including the disney nature films and christian evangelical filmmaking a number of wider overview chapters that examine contemporary american independent cinema from a number of perspectives together the chapters in the collection offer a unique contribution to the study of independent film in the united states contributors warren buckland philip drake mark gallagher geoff king peter krämer novotny lawrence james macdowell claire molloy michael z newman alisa perren james russell thomas schatz michele schreiber janet staiger yannis tzioumakis sarah wharton

independent cinema in china is not only made outside the commercial system but also without being submitted for censorship we know that for several decades it has been the crucible out of which china s most exciting new films have flowed the essays in this volume interrogate what else we think we know did it really start with wu wenguang and bumming in beijing in 1990 or can its roots be traced back much earlier what are its aesthetics and its

ethics including of gender and class where do audiences watch these films in china and how do they circulate and since the 2017 film law defined uncensored films as illegal is independent chinese cinema still alive what does it mean today and does it have a future the essays in this anthology many by exciting new scholars explore these urgent questions

from the prestige films of cagney productions to recent ultra low budget cult hits such as clerks and the blair witch project american independent cinema has produced some of the most distinctive films ever made this comprehensive introduction draws on key films filmmakers and film companies from the early twentieth century to the present to examine the factors that shaped this vital and evolving mode of filmmaking specifically it explores the complex and dynamic relations between independent and mainstream hollywood cinema showing how institutional industrial and economic changes in the latter have shaped and informed the former ordered chronologically the book begins with independent filmmaking in the studio era examining both top rank and low end film production moves to the 1950s and 1960s discussing both the adoption of independent filmmaking as the main method of production as well as exploitation filmmaking and finishes with contemporary american independent cinema exploring areas such as the new hollywood the rise of mini major and major independent companies and the institutionalization of independent cinema in the 1990s each chapter includes case studies which focus on specific films filmmakers and production and distribution companies

produced some of the most innovative and successful films of recent years from *sy rider* to *e blair* *witch project* but how independent is independent cinema today and what are the artistic and economic concerns that separate it from hollywood ntemporary american independent cinema is a comprehensive examination of the independent film scene exploring the uneasy relationship between independent films and the major studios the contributors trace the changing ideas and definitions of independent cinema and the diversity of independent film practices they consider the ways in which indie films are marketed and distributed and how new technologies such as video cable and the internet have offered new opportunities for filmmakers to produce and market independent films turning to the work of key auteurs such as *john sayles* and *haile gerima* contributors ask whether independent filmmakers can also be stars and consider how indie features like *ys don t cry* and *opping for fangs* address issues of gender sexuality and ethnicity normally avoided by hollywood
