era questo che la rendeva felice immaginare cose straordinarie dietro quelle più insospettabili sembra un'estate come tante nel piccolo borgo di tiglibianco le vecchiette si impicciano degli affari di tutti i bambini scorrazzano selvaggi le signore del club del libro infastidiscono la bibliotecaria ma ecco che villa edera la dimora vittoriana in fondo al paese viene affittata per qualche settimana da priscilla greenwood scrittrice di romanzi rosa di grandissimo successo in crisi d'ispirazione a caccia di tranquillità e anonimato per trovare il modo di liberarsi di calliope del topazio la sua smielata e ardente protagonista le cose a tiglibianco però non vanno come priscilla si aspetta comari in guerra gatti scomparsi ragazzine che sognano di diventare detective lettere trafugate un mitico quaderno di ricette smarrito da anni che contiene il segreto della torta più buona del mondo la suprema per non parlare della gara fragolina che si svolge ogni anno l'ultima domenica di luglio e in cui tutto il paese si sfida a colpi di torte di fragole e poi cesare burello il chirurgo plastico in vacanza nel paese natio È così che priscilla si trova immersa nel mezzo di un vero e proprio cliché da romanzo rosa cosa fare fuggire a gambe levate o dare una chance a cesare che sembra la copia carbone di roger macmillan l'affascinante protagonista dell'harmony che lei ha scritto fra picnic notturni complotti e una caccia al tesoro squisitamente letteraria priscilla si troverà finalmente a fare i conti con la domanda che la tormenta da sempre davvero la vita reale non può essere come un romanzo e intanto che fine avrà fatto la leggendaria ricetta della suprema la torta più buona del mondo scomparsa nel nulla trent'anni prima e il cui destino sembra legato a quello di cesare

petrarch's personification of the hapless lover has become one of our major models indeed in many of his poems of the pain and the bitter pleasure of love we recognize a vivid and timely picture of existential man humble sinner aesthete contemplative man of the world secretly tormented spirit droll observer and advocate of life petrarch's protagonist in these poems possesses a personality as complex as was the nature of his time the 366 poems of petrarch's canzoniere form one of the most influential books of poetry in western literature varied in form style and subject matter these scattered rhymes contain metaphors and conceits that have been absorbed into the literature and language of love in this definitive bilingual

edition of the canzoniere mark musa provides verse translations annotations and an introduction co authored with barbara manfredi

josef albers 1888 1976 è uno dei massimi esponenti dell astrattismo geometrico del novecento grazie all attività artistica condotta al bauhaus e grazie al ruolo di insegnante che rivestì allo stesso bauhaus e poi in america presso il black mountain college e presso la scuola d arte della yale university di cui fu direttore josef albers ha potuto esercitare una straordinaria influenza verso un intera generazione di artisti non a caso è stato il primo artista americano vivente cui il metropolitan museum of art di new york ha dedicato nel 1970 una mostra antologica personale concentrata in particolare sugli omaggi al quadrato celebre serie di dipinti alla quale albers si dedica fino alla morte avvenuta nel 1976 questo catalogo edito in occasione della mostra ideata per perugia da nicholas fox weber direttore della josef and anni albers foundation intende far conoscere l aspetto spirituale sotteso all arte di albers presentando una serie di opere che meglio esprimono la personale religiosità e la profonda immersione nel cattolicesimo dell artista teso verso la ricerca di quella che è stata definita una geometria dell assoluto il volume con numerosi testi critici è completato da una cronologia saggi di nicholas fox weber fabio de chirico fiona kearney paolo papone marco pierini colm tóibín julie agoos

francesco petrarca 1304 74 has been described as the first modern man of letters and his influence on the european lyric tradition has been widespread the poems of his canzoniere closely associated as they are with the enigmatic figure of laura were soon to become the models for love poetry in nearly all major european literatures in the renaissance the new translations here use the same rhyme schemes and broadly the same metres as those used by petrarch himself the facing english texts are thus not intended to be absolutely literal but to reflect the inner meanings and moods of the originals with some further literal translations of difficult passages added in the notes the notes to the poems also cover their likely dates mythological allusions certain background settings and a number of other calendrical and structural features which appear to emerge from the actual sequencing of the collection itself there is also a section on old italian syntax and other linguistic aids the new translation of petrarch s rerum vulgarian fragmenta is in two separate volumes
