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klappentext on 5th june 1984 the indian army began its attack on the complex at amritsar which houses the two most sacred shrines generals who had pledge to minimum force and on no account to violate the shrines were not

prepared for the fierce and adept resistance they encountered having suffered severe casualties the infantry were driven back and as last resorts with approval from delhi tanks were ordered in the akal takht was virtually reduced to rubble it is doubtful if mrs gandhi would have initiated operation blue star had she known how bloody and devastating would be the consequences of that 24 hour conflict

as the major geopolitical power bloc asia with 4 billion people two thirds of the world s population a huge land mass and the fastest growing economies has shifted the global political balance empires at war gives a dramatic narrative account of how modern asia came into being ranging over the whole of asia from japan to pakistan the modern history of this important region is placed in the context of the struggle between america and the soviet union francis pike shows that america s domination of post war asia was a continuation of a 100 year competition for power in the region he also argues cogently that contrary to the largely western centric viewpoint asian nations were not simply the passive and biddable entities of the superpowers but had a political development which was both separate and unique with a dynamic that was largely independent of the superpower conflict and in conclusion the book traces the unwinding of american influence and the end of its empire a crucial development in international history which is already having repercussions throughout the world

this is an updated and enlarged edition of the earlier book citadel of ice by the same author the book vividly describes indias epoch making daring scientific adventure in the icy continent of antarctica it narrates the story of a group of 12 scientists and soldiers who helped to establish the first ever over wintering indian base dakshin gangotri on a floating ice shelf in antarctica beginning with a description of the voyage to antarctica through the roaring forties icebergs pack ice and fast sea ice the book recounts the painstaking process of selecting a construction site for dakshin gangotri on a 400m thick continental ice shelf and the construction of the station right from its foundation to the commissioning of the life support systems the book then describes the hair raising incidents of the long antarctic blizzards where the wind many a time touched over 250km h with snow flying all around which threatened the very existence of the base it highlights the arduous struggles of psychological and biological adjustment with the mid night sun and polar night with the temperature going down to as low as 60 c the book also highlights the beauty of the aurora australis polar shadows mirage effects and other optical illusions presents an intriguing account of the expeditions through the polar ice cap with deep crevasses flowing rivers and treacherous lakes glaciers and nunataks the teams gallant efforts put india on the world map amongst the scientifically advanced nations the nation rewarded the teams achievement by awarding one kirti chakra two shourya chakras five sena medals and one vishishtha sewa medal which is the highest number of national awards won by any national mission this book now includes a vivid account of the later expeditions to antarctica along with their contribution to indian scientific research the book written by the leader of the team with a foreword by padma vibhushan dr s z qasim former member planning commission and secretary department of ocean development is
