abstract test taking has become a central component of the academic culture in today s high schools the federal government s increased emphasis on testing to determine accountability has had two significant consequences first with more and more testing students are expected to meet increasingly higher standards second students are required to meet these increasingly higher standards in order to be promoted or to graduate when high stakes tests prevent students from obtaining high school diplomas they lose important opportunities for continued education training and careers this study examined the beliefs emotions motivation and coping strategies used by students during test taking five hundred and seventy six ninth and tenth grade suburban high school students in a large midwestern city were sampled during a time when they were preparing to complete a high stakes state graduation test specifically to support the professional development of high school teachers we created a database with information concerning the types of emotions experienced during test taking the types of strategies used to cope with unpleasant emotions during tests and whether or not test taking was related to students feelings of school belonging the findings suggested that the typical suburban high school student is an adaptive test taker in other words the typical high school student fit the theoretical model of what a good student does to perform well on tests in addition to examining the typical high school student this study detailed differences by race gender school context and grade level the results suggested that tenth graders are more adaptive test takers than ninth graders in addition the findings suggested that girls are slightly more adaptive test takers than boys and that non white students are more adaptive test takers than their white counterparts
