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this is the first ever collection of plays by palestinian irish playwright hannah khalil the first woman of arab heritage to have a main stage play at the rsc it encompasses a decade s worth of plays exploring her arab heritage drawing on family histories as well as significant events in the arab world they were all written during a period that included the end of the war in iraq the intensification of the occupation of palestine and the birth and disillusion of the so called arab spring the plays included are set in both a historical and modern context they include a feminist take on 1001 nights and the scheherazade story an exploration of gertrude bell the museum in baghdad and britain s role in the birth of the iraq plus two plays looking at the palestinian experience one based on a family living through the creation of the state of israel in 1948 the other an epic collage that moves in time from 1948 to present day this anthology also includes a radio play set in dubai and a monologue about the power and legacy of artefacts it s notable that these plays offer a plethora of non stereotypical roles for actors of arab heritage through the six plays included the reader can trace a variety of approaches to storytelling a host of memorable characters and some unforgettable stories plays include plan d scenes from 73 years a negotiation museum in baghdad last of the pearl fishers hakawatis

in arabic instruction in israel allon j uhlmann confronts two conundrums namely the persistently poor level of arabic proficiency among jewish arabic students and teachers and the traumatic alienation of arab students by university arabic grammar instruction these are not aberrations but rather direct albeit unintended systemic consequences of the field of arabic instruction where jewish students encounter arabic as a dead hostile language jewish hegemony devalues native arabic proficiency and arab students are locked into a fractured educational trajectory encountering two alienating and mutually unintelligible grammars of arabic at school and at university by tracing systemic variabilities in cognition and learning uhlmann exposes hitherto misrecognised dynamics that hinder arabic instruction in israel thereby offering new avenues for possible change

in the middle of one of the worst civil wars in syria s history louise monaghan crossed a heavily guarded border to save her six year old daughter from the father who had callously snatched her from her home in cyprus not knowing what lay ahead the irish mother tricked her ex husband into believing she still loved him and wanted them to live together as a family purely so that she could see her kidnapped child again once in his homeland louise too was held captive locked inside a run down house day and night with little food and no hope of being released sick from polluted water severely beaten by her ex husband and abandoned by the turkish men paid to rescue her she took her little girl and made a daring escape the journey they made through bomb attacks and sniper fire and across a heavily patrolled mountain range in the dead of night was a harrowing ordeal yet miraculously they both survived and stolen is louise s breathtaking account of events

simultaneously like a family gone wrong mans loneliness and alienation religious intolerance financial charlatanism and racketeering racism in the guise of humanitarianism and international espionage in the end these elements intertwine toward a twisted end this makes for a really good read that will take you on a journey thats never boring
