a cue from anais nin s concept of the continuous autobiographical novel i have come to believe that it is not the possibility that she lied about her life that has upset so many people some of whom refer to this as a liary but that a woman should have such control over her own portrayal all the while defying so many of society s conventions anais nin may not have truly been the woman she portrays in this or future volumes but it is the woman she wanted to believe she was wanted the world to believe she was i find that quite revealing as revealing as any diary should be
