in 1970 photography curator peter c bunnell organized an exhibition called photography into sculpture for the museum of modern art new york the project which brought together twenty three photographers and artists from the united states and canada was among the first exhibitions to recognize work that blurred the boundaries between photography and other mediums at once an exhibition catalogue after the fact an oral history and a critical reading of exhibitions and experimental photography during the 1960s and 1970s the photographic object 1970 proposes precedents for contemporary artists who continue to challenge traditional practices and categories mary statzer has gathered a range of diverse materials including contributions from bunnell eva respini and drew sawyer erin o toole lucy soutter and rebecca morse as well as interviews with ellen brooks michael de courcy

richard jackson jerry mcmillan and other of the exhibition s surviving artists featuring seventy nine illustrations most of them in color this volume is an essential resource on a groundbreaking exhibition

hegel s philosophical interpretation of trinity as a dialectically developing movement of spirit is one of the most profound readings of trinity in western thought in hegel s trinitarian claim dale m schlitt provides a careful detailed presentation of this claim in hegel s major published works and in his lectures on the philosophy of religion taking a critical look at how hegel presents his claim that to think of god as subject and person one must think of god as trinity although agreeing with hegel s conclusion schlitt argues on the basis of an immanent critique of hegel s thought that hegel is not able to defend that claim in the way in which he proposes to do so schlitt argues instead that hegel s trinitarian claim can be justified when spirit is no longer seen as a movement of thought but as a movement of enriching experience this close analysis provides an excellent point of entry into the wider study and critical consideration of hegel s systematic philosophical project as a whole originally published in 1984 and available now in paperback for the first time this edition features a new preface and postscript

knowledge of the ideas of the theologian emanuel v gerhart is essential for understanding nineteenth century american theology gerhart was one of the first to introduce a complete systematic christocentric theological system to americans his institutes of the christian religion developed the ideas of european theologians and promoted the effort to systematize mercersburg theology gerhart embraced german idealism rather than scottish philosophy in his scholarship as a mediating theologian he attempted to reconcile historical christianity with modern culture his lectures essays and texts addressed the religious challenges and intellectual issues of his day from a christocentric perspective together they were a major contribution to the mercersburg movement in particular and american theology in general from the antebellum period to the progressive era his publications were devoted to a range of disciplines that included education philosophy and theology this volume portrays gerhart s core theological ideas as found in his main texts and offers introductory commentaries and gives the historical background for his intellectual contributions
