showed that the trigger for incubator search is office space furthermore the decision making distinguishes itself between experienced and inexperienced entrepreneurs experienced mostly use search engines such as google whereas inexperienced entrepreneurs obtain information through their close social circles criteria for decision making for experienced entrepreneurs are tangible services such as infrastructure and location whereas for inexperienced entrepreneurs intangible services such as networking and coaching are valuable the findings allow introducing a model that is useful for both existing and future incubators with suggestions to service offerings and future start ups providing suggestions about the decision making process
