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heinz a heinz was the only writer authorized by the nazi party to draw a biography of the fu hrer for publication in the english speaking world the result was the 1938 authorized biography of adolf hitler entitled germany s hitler the book was based on interviews supplied first hand by those friends helpers and comrades who had believed in him from the beginning of his political career heinz a heinz was a professional journalist and author he interviewed hitler s old school friends army colleagues landlords his jailer and early party comrades including an invaluable interview with anton drexler to produce an unprecedented insight into adolf hitler as viewed by his acquaintances during the inter war period these remarkable interviews were given by those who had stood by him in his darkest days and who lived to see one of the most astounding political achievements in history included are vivid and unique descriptions of hitler at school his first world war battlefield experiences the early political struggles the full story behind the 9th november beer hall putsch hitler in prison and the struggle to power from 1926 to 1933 featuring a new introduction by emmy award winning writer and historian bob carruthers this book is a vital primary source reference work for anyone interested in understanding how and why hitler won the total adulation and support of such a large section of the german people

august kubizek met adolf hitler in 1904 while they were both competing for standing room at the opera their mutual passion for music created a strong bond and over the next four years they became close friends kubizek describes a reticent young man painfully shy yet capable of bursting into hysterical fits of anger if anyone disagreed with him the two boys would often talk for hours on end hitler found kubizek to be a very good listener a worthy confidant to his hopes and dreams in 1908 kubizek moved to vienna and shared a room with hitler at 29 stumpergasse during this time hitler tried to get into art school but he was unsuccessful with his money fast running out he found himself sinking to the lower depths of the city an unkind world of isolation and constant unappeasable hunger hitler moved out of the flat in november without leaving a forwarding address kubizek did not meet his friend again until 1938 the young hitler i knew tells the story of an extraordinary friendship and gives fascinating insight

into hitler s character during these formative years this is the first edition to be published in english since 1955 and it corrects many changes made for reasons of political correctness it also includes important sections which were excised from the original english translation

here s adolf hitler in a series of bizarre photographs which he kept hidden from the world they have now been published in this memoir daily express heinrich hoffman was a key part in the making of the hitler legend the photographer who carefully crafted the image of the fuhrer as a godlike figure hoffmann published his first book of photographs in 1919 following his work as an official photographer for the german army in 1920 he joined the nazi party and his association with hitler began he became hitler s official photographer and traveled with him extensively he took over two million photographs of hitler and they were distributed widely including on postage stamps an enterprise that proved very profitable for both men hoffmann published several books on hitler in the 1930s including the hitler nobody knows 1933 hoffmann and hitler were very close and he acted not only as a personal confidante his memoirs include rare details of the fuhrer but also as a matchmaker it is hoffmann who introduced eva braun his studio assistant to hitler at the end of the war hoffmann was arrested by the us military who also seized his photographic archive and was sentenced to imprisonment for nazi profiteering this edition of a classic book includes photographs by hoffmann and a new introduction by roger moorhouse an extraordinary new book of photographs of adolf hitler includes one that so embarrassed him he banned it from being published it shows the f hrer in his lederhosen striking an absurdly camp pose as he leans against a tree the times

a rare and fascinating insight into hitler s inner circle roger moorhouse author of killing hitler as secretary to the f hrer throughout the time of the third reich christa schroeder was perfectly placed to observe the actions and behavior of hitler along with the most important figures surrounding him schroeder s memoir delivers fascinating insights she notes his bourgeois manners his vehement abstemiousness and his mood swings indeed she was ostracized by hitler for a number of months after

she made the mistake of publicly contradicting him once too often in addition to her portrayal of hitler there are illuminating anecdotes about hitler s closest colleagues she recalls for instance that the relationship between martin bormann and his brother albert who was on hitler s personal staff was so bad that the two would only communicate with one another via their respective adjutants even if they were in the same room there is also light shed on the peculiar personal life and insanity of reichsminister walther darré schroeder claims to have known nothing of the horrors of the nazi regime there is nothing of the sense of perspective or the mea culpa that one finds in the memoirs of hitler s other secretary traudl junge who concluded we should have known rather the tone that pervades schroeder s memoir is one of bitterness this is without any doubt one of the most important primary sources from the prewar and wartime period

a biography of hitler by his long serving press chief and close associate up to the last moment his overwhelming despotic authority aroused false hopes and deceived his people and his entourage only at the end when i watched the inglorious collapse and the obstinacy of his final downfall was i able suddenly to fit together the bits of mosaic i had been amassing for twelve years into a complete picture of his opaque and sphinx like personality otto dietrich when otto dietrich was invited in 1933 to become adolf hitler s press chief he accepted with the simple uncritical conviction that adolf hitler was a great man dedicated to promoting peace and the welfare for the german people at the end of the war imprisoned and disillusioned dietrich sat down to write what he had seen and heard in twelve years of the closest association with hitler requesting that it be published after his death dietrich s role placed him in a privileged position he was hired by hitler in 1933 and was a confidant until 1945 and he worked and clashed with joseph goebbels his direct personal experience of life at the heart in the reich makes for compelling reading

this is the personal account of a luftwaffe aide always at hitler s side from 1937 until the last days in berlin now published for the first time in english nicolaus von below was a 29 year old pilot when

goering selected him for the position of hitler s luftwaffe adjutant he was with hitler at every stage as the second world war unfolded his observations tell of hitler s responses to momentous events as well as military decisions and policy making at fuhrer headquarters this is a superb source describing life in hitler s inner circle relied upon on by gitta sereny in her biography of albert speer he provides fascinating insight into how hitler planned the invasions of poland and russia what he thought of britain and america why he placed his faith in the v 1 and v 2 projects how others dealt with him and much more von below was present at the assassination attempt in july 1944 and records the effect on hitler and his followers von below was the last of hitler s close military entourage to emerge from the bunker alive his frank memoir will appeal to anyone interested in how hitler ran his war he was denounced to the british in 1946 and imprisoned as a material witness at nuremberg until being discharged in 1947

creepy yet fascinating of interest to anyone seeking more insight into the everyday life of one of history s monsters library journal heinz linge worked with adolf hitler for a ten year period from 1935 until the fuhrer s death in the berlin bunker in may 1945 he was one of the last to leave the bunker and was responsible for guarding the door while hitler killed himself during his years of service linge was responsible for all aspects of hitler s household and was constantly by his side he claims that only eva braun stood closer to hitler during these years through a host of anecdotes and observations linge recounts the daily routine in hitler s household his eating habits his foibles his preferences his sense of humor and his private life with braun in fact linge believed hitler s closest companion was his dog after the war linge said in an interview it was easier for him to sign a death warrant for an officer on the front than to swallow bad news about the health of his dog in a number of instances such as with the stauffenberg bomb plot of july 1944 linge gives an excellent eyewitness account of events he also gives thumbnail profiles of the prominent members of hitler s court hess speer bormann and ribbentrop among them now linge s incredible story has been translated into english for the first time and casts

new light on what it was like to be constantly alongside the nazi despot daily mail

an absolute classic of autobiography and history one of the few books to explore how and why the germans were seduced by hitler and nazism if you have never read a book about nazi germany before or if you have already read a thousand i would urge you to read *Defying Hitler* it sings with wisdom and understanding daily mail sebastian haffner was a non jewish german who emigrated to england in 1938 this memoir written in 1939 but only published now for the first time begins in 1914 when the family summer holiday is cut short by the outbreak of war and ends with hitler s assumption of power in 1933 it is a portrait of himself and his own generation in germany those born between 1900 and 1910 and brilliantly explains through his own experiences and those of his friends how that generation came to be seduced by hitler and nazism the germans lacked an outlet for self expression where the french had amour food and wine and the british their gardens and their pets the germans had nothing leading to a tendency towards mass psychosis the upheaval of post wwi revolution factionalism and inflation left the germans addicted to excitement and action hitler provided this and more

illustrated with 24 plates of maps and diagrams and 13 photographs originally published in germany in 1955 and in england and the united states in 1958 this classic memoir of wwii by a man who was an acknowledged military genius and probably germany s top wwii general is now made available again field marshal erich von manstein described his book as a personal narrative of a soldier discussing only those matters that had direct bearing on events in the military field the essential thing as he wrote is to know how the main personalities thought and reacted to events this is what he tells us in this book his account is detailed yet dispassionate and objective nothing is certain in war when all is said and done but in manstein s record at least we can see clearly what forces were in action in retrospect perhaps his book takes on an even greater significance print ed

The author was born in Dresden in 1924, the year Hitler's *Mein Kampf* was published. Growing up during the pre-war Nazi years, he joined the Hitler Jugend. Following harsh basic training, he was sent to the Eastern Front where he saw combat near Kursk. Captured by the Russians, he escaped and was transferred to the Italian campaign with his acquired knowledge of Italian and local conditions. He volunteered for the Special Forces Division Brandenburg where he was trained in sabotage and intelligence gathering, operating behind enemy lines and wreaking havoc with the enemy's command, communication, and logistical structures. Arriving on leave in Dresden during the February 1945 firebombing, he recounts the terrible aftermath, including the extrication and burial of his father from the ruins of Dresden. Bank of one of the most devastating and controversial attacks of the Second World War. Following his return to Italy and the subsequent

capitulation of german forces he was detained as a pow in northern italy for almost two years battle hardened and disillusioned he used all his clandestine and organisational skills to initiate successful black market operations while working as an interpreter for the british army imprisoned in austria as an escapee he finally returned to a shattered germany in 1947 where he elected to remain illegally in the us zone of occupation what follows is a gripping story of survival and an insight into the hardships and privations facing the german people leading to the wiederaufbau much more than a military narrative the author presents a candid view into the mind and soul of the german people for all it was worth is an account of hitler s germany and its consequences and is a remarkable document of value to post war generations as well as historians and students of world war ii

as an interpreter in the german foreign ministry paul otto schmidt 1899 1970 was in attendance at some of the most decisive moments of twentieth century history fluent in both english and french he served as hitler s translator during negotiations with chamberlain the british declaration of war and the surrender of france as well as translating the f hrer s infamous speeches for radio having gained favour with the nazi party donning first the uniform of the ss then that of the luftwaffe paul schmidt was given absolute authority in everything to do with foreign languages he later presided over the interrogation of canadian soldiers captured after the 1942 dieppe raid arrested in may 1945 schmidt was freed by the americans in 1948 in 1946 he testified at the nuremberg trials where conversations with him were noted down by the psychiatrist leon goldensohn and later published after the war he taught at the sprachen und dolmetscher institut in munich hitler s interpreter presents a highly atmospheric account of the bizarre life led behind the scenes at the highest level of the third reich roger moorhouse is a historian of the third reich he is the author of the acclaimed berlin at war killing hitler and the devil s pact he has contributed to he was my chief i was hitler s chauffeur with hitler to the end and hitler s last witness

inside the third reich is a memoir written by albert speer the nazi minister of armaments from 1942 to 1945 serving as adolf hitler s main architect before this period it is considered to be one of the most detailed descriptions of the inner workings and leadership of nazi germany but is controversial because of speer s lack of discussion of nazi atrocities and questions regarding his degree of awareness or involvement with them

having grown up and trained as a lawyer in t oronto shulman worked as an intelligence officer and was

responsible for interviewing German prisoners of war in this book he chronicles his own fascinating life history

Hitler's path to war consisted of two different stages that paralleled the internal development of Germany from 1933 to the end of 1936 he created a diplomatic revolution in Europe from a barely accepted equal Germany became the dominant power on the continent with the remilitarization of the Rhineland the stalemate in the Spanish Civil War the forming of the Axis and the signing of the anti

comintern pact the first phase was completed in the second phase the diplomatic initiative in the world belonged to germany and its partners germany s march toward war therefore became the central issue in world diplomacy

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
