carbon¹² 6 protons 6 neutrons and carbon¹⁴ 6 protons 8 neutrons Both are carbon because they have 6 protons but they have different mass numbers due to the varying number of neutrons

How to Represent Isotopes Isotopes are often represented using the element symbol followed by the mass number as a superscript C¹² carbon¹² and C¹⁴ carbon¹⁴

Advanced Practice Problems Problem 4 Potassium has three naturally occurring isotopes K³⁹ 93.26%, K⁴⁰ 0.01% and K⁴¹ 6.73% Explain what this means and how the average atomic mass is calculated

Answer This means that potassium exists in nature as three different isotopes each with a different mass number and abundance The average atomic mass is calculated by taking a weighted average of the mass numbers of each isotope considering its relative abundance

Problem 5 An unknown element X has two isotopes X⁷⁰ abundance 0.70 and X³⁰ abundance 0.30 Calculate the average atomic mass of element X Assume the mass numbers are approximately equal to the atomic mass in amu

Answer Average atomic mass = $0.70(70) + 0.30(30) = 49.0$ amu
