this book engages with the concept queer battle fatigue which is the everyday exhaustion that lgbtqia people and communities often experience from anti queer norms and values contributors express how this concept is often experienced across spaces and places from schools to communities queer battle fatigue is one way to express the everyday exhaustion that lgbtqia people and communities often feel that is a result sociopolitical and cultural anti queer norms and values in this volume contributors think about how queer battle fatigue hits bodies and their multiple ways of being knowing and doing

chapters describe how such violence flows from early childhood experiences to universities and across community spaces contributors also describe how people and communities resist and refuse anti queer norms and values carving out pathways to live love and have joy despite everyday oppressions from calling on black queer ancestors to using stem education as a safe space to artistic representations of identities the chapters in queer battle fatigue ask readers to consider how to disrupt and deconstruct anti queer norms while also engaging in the many beautiful forms of queer joy as an act of resistance queer battle fatigue will be a key resource for academics researchers and advanced students of education qualitative research queer theory and gender studies educational research and curriculum studies the chapters included in this book were originally published as a special issue of international journal of qualitative studies in education

preparing for an audition and unsure of what you want to do the ultimate scene and monologue sourcebook is the book you've been waiting for unlike scene books that reprint 50 to 75 monologues excerpted from plays but don't include any background information this annotated guide tells you what you really need to know about audition material from more than 300 contemporary plays here is how the book works suppose that you're looking for a dramatic male female scene when you scan part one play synopses and analyses you come across an entry for the middle of the night by paddy chayefsky this is what you see the middle of the night by paddy chayefsky samuel french synopsis a kindly 53 year old widower falls in love with a 23 year old woman who is unhappily married to a musician no one in their circle of acquaintances approves of this union but their love is true analysis excellent human drama frequently touching actors who play the widower need to have a good feel for new york city brooklyn speech patterns this sensitivity isn't as essential for the part of the woman all levels scenes monologues male monologues 1 female female scenes 1 male female scenes 2 in addition to basic information about the play author and publisher the entry provides you with the story line a critique of the play and the number of audition worthy monologues and scenes it contains if the description of this particular play piques your interest your next step is to turn to part six male female scenes for specifics about the selection this is what you'll see there the middle of the night by paddy chayefsky samuel french drama act ii scene 2 pp 40 44 the manufacturer 53 and the 23 after an unsatisfactory attempt at lovemaking the manufacturer feels awful that he wasn't able to perform usually he is very understanding he then asks her to marry him the actor playing the manufacturer must have a good feel for regional new york speech patterns this skill is less critical for the actress playing the start the manufacturer i'm sorry betty end the manufacturer oh my sweet i love you so much you don't know if you change your mind tomorrow i won't be angry with you i won't lie to you betty i'm afraid this entry tells you what type of scene this is dramatic where you'll find the selection act scene and page numbers the length of the scene the names and ages of the characters the context in which the characters are speaking and the first and last lines of the scene if the material seems appropriate all you have to do is get a copy of the play and get to work because the ultimate scene and monologue sourcebook enables you to make informed decisions about the suitability of more than 1 000

monologues and scenes which you can find easily through the book's extensive cross indexes you'll gain a critical edge in the auditioning process

hollywood's italian american filmmakers explores the different ways in which italian american directors from the **1920s** to the present have responded to their ethnicity while some directors have used film to declare their ethnic roots and create an italian american imagined community others have ignored or even denied their background jonathan j cavallero examines the films of frank capra martin scorsese nancy savoca francis ford coppola and quentin tarantino with a focus on what the films reveal about each director's view on italian american identities whereas capra's films highlight similarities between immigrant characters and wasp americans scorsese accepts his ethnic heritage but also sees it as confining similarly many of coppola's films provide a nostalgic treatment of italian american identity but with little criticism of the culture's more negative aspects and while savoca's movies reveal her artful ability to recognize how ethnic gender and class identities overlap tarantino's films exhibit a playfully postmodern engagement with italian american ethnicity cavallero's exploration of the films of capra scorsese savoca coppola and tarantino demonstrates how immigrant italians fought prejudice how later generations positioned themselves in relation to their predecessors and how the american cinema usually seen as a cultural institution that works to assimilate has also served as a forum where assimilation was resisted
