the jewish study of jesus has made enormous strides within the last two hundred years virtually every aspect of the life of jesus and related themes have been analyzed and discussed jesus has been reclaimed as a fellow jew by many although what this actually means remains a matter for discussion ironically the one event in the life of jesus that has received significantly less attention is the one that the new testament proclaims as the most important of all his resurrection from the dead this book is the first attempt to document jewish views of the resurrection of jesus in history and modern scholarship

most characters in the bible are men yet they are hardly analysed as such masculinity and the bible provides the first comprehensive survey of approaches that remedy this situation these are studies that utilize insights from the field of masculinity studies to further biblical studies the volume offers a representative overview of both fields and presents a new exegesis of a well known biblical text mark 6 to show how this approach leads to new insights by presenting the field of masculinity studies the volume performs a service for those working in biblical studies and related disciplines but have not explored this approach yet at the same time the volume shows by surveying the past two decades of publications in the field what results have been achieved so far and where open questions remain in the exegesis of mark 6 it becomes clear that one of these challenges the often very specific and intersectional character of masculinity can be addressed successfully when consciously combining approaches such as narrative and ritual analyses

the irish writer george moore 1852 1933 was a very significant and often controversial figure on the literary stages of paris london and dublin at a key cultural moment between 1880 and 1931 his creative involvements included spells with literary theatres in london and dublin jousts with the daring and repression of the fin de siècle and a hail and farewell to yeats and the irish revival this collection of essays offers fresh insights into diverse elements of his œuvre and reflects some of the wide variety in moore's literary innovations influences and legacy contributors note his pioneering contributions to the short story his penetrating insights into greek classical literature

his avant garde feminism and egalitarianism and what may surprise 21st century readers of biblical theme blockbusters his sensitive but contentious novelistic treatment of the historical Jesus in this volume there are studies of sophisticated composition and fresh approaches to textual analysis the multiple Moore talents are scrutinised myths are dispelled and new evidence is uncovered for historic linkages George Moore's anticipation of Freudian psychological insights and his engagement with Darwinian theses are but two of his close involvements with key nineteenth century figures Manet Degas Parnell Kant Maupassant Gladstone Zola Marx and Woolf must feature on the list of names that are inseparable from Moore's life and work Yeats and Joyce also loom large and their under acknowledged indebtedness to Moore poses difficult questions for literary history while Moore's own debt to French artistic influences English models and Irish heritage has long been recognised perceptions of Moore's writing from outside the Anglophone world highlight issues that demand further consideration this multi faceted author is well served by these new studies that in turn suggest additional avenues yet to be explored

George Moore once complained after warmly appreciative reviews of a novel so few bother to analyse the book carefully it would have been very easy to discuss the form compare my treatment of it with others treatment of similar themes and so on yet apparently no one has ever thought of that this rueful remark was the starting point in Richard Cave's design of this study he has examined each of Moore's novels in detail and viewed them within the pattern of his total development and in the context of Moore's current reading and ideas about technique as well as assessing the value of a wide range of influences to him professor Cave's study is basically divided into three parts the novel of social realism which deals with *A Modern Lover* *A Mummer's Wife* *A Drama in Muslin* and *Esther Waters* a phase of experiment deals with new influences and the resultant problems the four novellas *Wagner's Influence* *Evelyn Innes* and *Sister Teresa* and *Styles for Consciousness* *The Lake* *The Brook* *Kerith* and the late historical novels followed by a conclusion

the contribution of the Johannine literature to the development of Christian theology and particularly to Christology is uncontested although careful distinction between the implications of its language especially that of sonship in a first century Jewish context and in the subsequent theological controversies of the early church has been

particularly important if not always easily sustained recent study has shaken off the weight of subsequent christian appropriation of johannine language which has sometimes made readers immune to the ambiguities and challenging tensions in its thought the oxford handbook of johannine studies begins with chapters concentrating on discussions of the background and context of the johannine literature leading to the different ways of reading the text and thence to the primary theological themes within them before concluding with some discussion of the reception of the johannine literature in the early church inevitably given their different genres and levels of complexity some chapters pay most if not all attention to the gospel whereas others are more able to give a more substantial place to the letters all the contributors have themselves made significant contributions to their topic they have sought to give a balanced introduction to the relevant scholarship and debate but they have also been able to present the issues from their own perspective the handbook will help those less familiar with the johannine literature to get a sense of the major areas of debate and why the field continues to be one of vibrant and exciting study and that those who are already part of the conversation will find new insights to enliven their own on going engagement with these writings
