between dignity and despair draws on the extraordinary memoirs diaries interviews and letters of jewish women and men to give us the first intimate portrait of jewish life in nazi germany focusing on the fate of families and particularly women s experience kaplan takes us into the neighborhoods into the kitchens shops and schools to give us the shape and texture the very feel of what it was like to be a jew in nazi germany
