this research handbook examines the evolution of understandings and legal definitions of domestic abuse illustrating the importance of expanding these beyond physical violence to encompass coercive control drawing on academic literature legal doctrine and the lived experiences of victims and survivors it highlights how responses to domestic abuse can be improved in civil family and criminal justice systems

the research methodology and the problems encountered when studying a subject such as domestic violence coupled with the ethical problems of researching with children are discussed at length in the book this gives a good insight into the intricacies of conducting such a research study the research looked not only at children who were known to have direct contact with domestic violence but also what children in general thought and felt about domestic violence the presentation of the findings both in tabular and narrative form was well presented accident and emergency nursing journal this book offers accessible and interesting reading it is well written as one would expect from these authors there are a lot of pointers for the way forward in terms of both policy and practice this is likely to become a seminal text research policy and planning this is a useful and challenging read for all of us who seek to work effectively and ethically in this complex area of practice professional social work just looking at the authors of this book tells the reader that they are about to embark on a pioneering piece of academic research a comprehensive and authoritative piece of work domestic abuse quarterly a vital tool for all those working with children childright written in a lucid style and is easy to read it is essential reading for all students in social work undergraduate courses and also in post qualifying courses on child welfare and protection in addition professionals who are directly working in the area of child protection schools and criminal justice settings would find this book informative and useful in understanding what children and young people want and need in relation to living in domestic violence situations child and family social work this book is powerfully written and is essential reading for professional working with and supporting abused women and their children its groundbreaking focus on children s experiences adds much to our understanding of the complexities of domestic violence journal of family studies a treasure chest of rich diverse and powerful extracts from children and young people in particular the material presented on different coping strategies used by children who have experienced domestic violence is an important contribution to an area about which very little is known adoption

the book aims to explore the exciting opportunities offered by a systemic approach for mental health professionals and psychotherapists when working with families and other systems where domestic violence in intimate relationships is of concern the main purpose of the book lies in the application of systemic thinking to safety and to understanding the complexity of domestic violence on family relationships over time the authors outline their approach to these complex issues based on their eight years of joint experience in the reading safer families project they draw from a broad field of family psychology and systemic psychotherapy to distil the theories methods and techniques most helpful to practitioners working in modern public and voluntary agencies their systemic approach to issues of risk responsibility and collaboration provides a coherent framework within which to integrate practice the book also provides a practice orientated and detailed approach to risk assessment risk management and family

building on the success of previous editions this book has been expanded to integrate the criminal justice system into a broad systemic response for both victims and offenders

despite changes to laws and policies across most western democracies intended to combat violence to women intimate partner violence and abuse ipva remains discouragingly commonplace domestic violence and psychology critical perspectives on intimate partner violence and abuse showcases women s harrowing stories of living with and leaving violent partners offering a psychological perspective on domestic violence and developing a theoretical framework for examining the context intentions and experiences in the lives of people who experience abuse and abuse themselves nicolson provides an analysis of survivors real life stories and thoughts about ipva the attitudes of the general public and health and social care professionals are also presented and discussed the theoretical perspective employs three levels of evidence the material context discursive explanations and intrapsychic emotional domestic violence and psychology is divided into three parts accordingly engaging qualitative data from interviews and quantitative data from surveys to illustrate these theoretical perspectives although many pro feminist sociologists and activists firmly believe that any attempt to explain domestic violence potentially condones it

this book takes up the challenge to make a compelling case demonstrating how we need to widen understanding of the psychology of survivors and their intimate relationships if we are to defeat ipva the new edition has been updated to include the latest developments in ipva research and practice and in particular examines the impact of a violent and abusive family life on all members including children this is essential reading for students academics and professionals interested in domestic abuse as well as professionals and practitioners including psychologists social workers the police prison officers probation staff policy makers and charity workers

examining the prevalent issue of domestic violence this book breaks down the reasons behind the ineffectiveness of existing human rights instruments and the gaps in current legal systems failing those in need through a variety of key case studies it reveals significant gaps in the legal conceptualisation of domestic violence between human rights standards on the one hand and the national legal systems examined those of ireland and lithuania on the other the book reveals that contrary to gender based universal human rights approaches and despite recent legislative reforms the legal concept of domestic violence is gender blind it fails to capture gender based empirical realities on the ground rendering national legal systems devoid of an empirically informed theoretical basis for addressing the problem despite the differences in the contextual backgrounds of the two case study countries the legislation on domestic violence is underpinned by patriarchal beliefs in both this book employs a gender based examination of the issue that will be of key interest to scholars legal practitioners civil society actors and students of feminist legal theory gender equality gender in international law gender and human rights and conceptual democracy

aims to provide information on a variety of traditional and breakthrough issues in the complex phenomenon of domestic violence
