efforts at coordination between nations are at the heart of the challenges of globalization despite steadily growing interdependencies individual nations still have specific interests that present obstacles to globalization while some challenges inspired by the need to coordinate are viewed as inevitable by many they are less optimistic about prospects for success jan erik lane argues that one should focus objectively upon the possibility of failures lane analyzes four kinds of challenges to interdependency all of which are growing in geopolitical relevance first countries need to diminish their dependency on fossil fuel and shift to a reliable supply of energy because fossil fuels are diminishing second environmental degradation must be addressed because it is accelerating under the strain of earth s population lane advocates an ecological footprint approach third a single global market economy and its complexities must be addressed as national economies are increasingly opened finally as traditional state sovereignty weakens foreign military intervention in both international and intra state conflicts increases governments are attempting to address these interdependencies or reply to the challenges they pose mainly through international organizations and regionalism these efforts are discussed at length in addition problems with international law are reviewed as lane warns against the utopian hopes of global constitutionalism globalization also examines the potential consequences of failing to address the need for coordination in efforts to address shared global challenges

this book explores the question of how the multiplication of judicial decisions on international law has influenced

the way in which legal findings in international law adjudication are justified international law practitioners frequently cite judicial decisions to persuade courts interpreting international law are no exception to this practice however judicial decisions do much more than persuading they enable and constrain interpretive discretion instead of taking the road of the sources of international law this book turns to the somewhat uncharted terrain of legal argumentation using international criminal law as a case study it shows how the growing number of judicial decisions has normalised courts resort to them in legal justification and enabled some argumentative practices to become constitutive of international law in so doing it critically revisits the implications of an iterative use of judicial decisions and reassesses the influence of the judicialisation turn on the ways in which the meaning of international law is formed shaped and reshaped by reference to judicial decisions

this book aims to focus the discussion of metaphysics by introducing it via aristotle s view that it is the science of being as being and delineating key types of being through the various chapters figures covered briefly include aristotle heraclitus protagoras ockham leibniz locke hume and russell neglected and important arguments by figures like aquinas and ockham are brought to light each chapter is divided into short and easily readable sections including an introduction which raises a problem an account of key views criticisms of those views and a brief conclusion there are also recommended further readings at the end of each chapter which would be useful to anyone teaching a topic in the area

this unique new work of reference traces the origins of the modern laws of warfare from the earliest times to the present day relying on written records from as far back as 2400 bce and using sources ranging from the bible to security council resolutions the author pieces together the history of a subject which is almost as old as civilisation itself the author shows that as long as humanity has been waging wars it has also been trying to find ways of legitimising different forms of combatants and ascribing rules to them protecting civilians who are either inadvertently or intentionally caught up between them and controlling the use of particular classes of weapons that may be used in times of conflict thus it is that this work is divided into three substantial parts volume 1 on the laws affecting combatants and captives volume 2 on civilians and volume 3 on the law of arms control this second book on civilians examines four different topics the first topic deals with the targetting of civilians in times of war this discussion is one which has been largely governed by the developments of technologies which have allowed projectiles to be discharged over ever greater areas and attempts to prevent their indiscriminate utilisation have struggled to keep pace the second topic concerns the destruction of the natural environment with particular regard to the utilisation of starvation as a method of warfare and unlike the first topic this one has rarely changed

over thousands of years although contemporary practices are beginning to represent a clear break from tradition the third topic is concerned with the long standing problems of civilians under the occupation of opposing military forces where the practices of genocide collective punishments and or reprisals and rape have occurred the final topic in this volume is about the theft or destruction of the property of the enemy in terms of either pillage or the intentional devastation of the cultural property of the opposition as a work of reference this set of three books is unrivalled and will be of immense benefit to scholars and practitioners researching and advising on the laws of warfare it also tells a story which throws fascinating new light on the history of international law and on the history of warfare itself

this book asks whether there any limits to the sorts of religious considerations that can be raised in public debates and if there are by whom they are to be identified its starting point is the work of richard rorty whose pragmatic pluralism leads him to argue for a politically motivated anticlericalism rather than an epistemologically driven atheism rather than defend rorty s position directly gascoigne argues for an epistemological stance he calls pragmatist fideism the starting point for this exercise in what rorty calls cultural politics is an acknowledgement that one must appeal to both secularists and those with religious commitments in recent years reformed epistemologists have aimed to establish a parity of epistemic esteem between religious and perceptual beliefs by exploiting an analogy in respect of their mutual vulnerability to sceptical challenges through an examination of this analogy and in light of wittgenstein s on certainty this book argues that understood correctly the parity argument in fact lends epistemological support to the argument that religious considerations should not be raised in public debate the political price paid paying the price of politics is worth it the religious thinker is provided with a good reason for maintaining that their practices and beliefs are not undermined by other forms of religious life

there are three themed parts to this book values ethics and emotions in the first part epistemology perception and consciousness in the second part and philosophy of mind and philosophy of language in the third part papers in this volume provide links between emotions and values and explore dependency between language meanings and concepts and topics such as the liar s paradox reference and metaphor are examined this book is the second of a two volume set that originates in papers presented to professor kevin mulligan covering the subjects that he contributed to during his career this volume opens with a paper by moya who proposes that there is an asymmetrical relation between the possibility of choice and moral responsibility the first part of this volume ends with a description of foolishness as insensitivity to the values of knowledge by engel marconi s article makes three negative claims about relative truth and sundholm notes shortcomings of the english language for epistemology amongst other papers this section ends with a discussion of the term subjective character by nida rümelin who finds it misleading the third part of this volume contains papers exploring topics such as the mind body problem whether theory of mind is based on simulation or theory and künne shows that the most common analyses of the so called liar paradox are wanting at the end of this section rizzi introduces syntactic cartography and illustrates its use in scope discourse semantics this second volume contains twenty nine chapters written by both high profile and upcoming researchers from across europe north america and north africa the first volume of this set has two main themes metaphysics especially truth making and the notion of explanation and the second theme is the history of philosophy with an emphasis on austrian philosophy

only god is truly wise human wisdom is of little or no value declaimed plato in his apology and yet the ancient greeks including plato himself more than any other people of antiquity were fascinated by the pursuit of the wisdom they called philosophia that search for knowledge involved an extensive use of maxims and quotations as we can see from those expressions of homer prefaced by the phrase as people say classical greek lore and sagacity have throughout history continued to provide inspiration to figures as diverse as the church fathers shakespeare nietzsche marx and john f kennedy indeed homer the seven sages and the pre socratic philosophers are still extensively quoted in all the major western languages while the admired sayings of heraclitus for instance are known only through his quotations his actual writings having long been lost yet for all their popularity and ubiquity until now there has been no single resource for these quotations to which interested readers might turn this unique and handsome reference book offers one of the most comprehensive selections of greek quotations

ever committed to print organised alphabetically with the original greek followed by an accompanying english translation it collects some 7500 entries ranging from the archaic period to late antiquity and across philosophy drama poetry history science and medicine containing a full list of translators and of abbreviations its index of key words enables the fast and efficient sourcing of each entry this is a handbook designed for years of pleasurable and profitable browsing many readers may find that the views expressed twenty centuries ago and now helpfully contained between one set of covers are as pertinent and provocative today as they were then

creates room for autonomous rational choices that are not dictated by reason besides insight into incommensurability promotes recognition of different possible rankings of universally valid but sometimes conflicting human values this book avoids unnecessary technical language and is accessible not only for specialists but for a large audience of philosophers ethicists political theorists economists lawyers and interested persons without specialized knowledge
