conceptual and research approach to adolescent development in my lifetime was made by muzafer sherif sherif cantril 1947 of columbia university during my student days there in the 1930 s and 1940 s he insightfully conceptualized
adolescence as a transitional biosocial interactional and marginal stage of personality development involving an abrupt shift from a derived and dependent status to an earned independent competence based marginal status and self esteem
with associated personality deficits and compensatory interim status in my 1952 and thereafter textbooks i applied this primary and central theory of adolescent development to all of the component functional areas of adolescence see
