in recent years many christian clergy laity and mental health professionals have rediscovered the ancient practices of spiritual direction seen as a refreshing alternative to the techniques and limitations of modern psychology such practices offer new insights for pastoral care but many remain unclear on what spiritual direction is and whether its methods are applicable to their own clients and parishioners spiritual direction is a practice of christian soul care that is found most notably in the catholic orthodox and episcopal traditions but is also present in wesleyan holiness pentecostal charismatic social justice and reformed communities predating modern counseling and psychotherapy movements but sharing key principles and insights for spiritual formation spiritual direction offers significant resources for today's pastors counselors therapists chaplains and other caregivers attuned to the work of god in people's lives in this landmark volume editors gary w moon and david g benner along with a team of expert contributors provide a comprehensive survey of spiritual direction in its myriad christian forms specific chapters offer careful historical perspective and contemporary analysis of how christians from various backgrounds have practiced spiritual direction with particular attention to each tradition's definition of spiritual direction the process of authentic transformation the role of the spiritual director indicators of mature spirituality and other aspects of the spiritual direction process chapters also provide psychological and clinical insight into how spiritual direction is similar to different from and can be integrated with psychotherapy and pastoral counseling to help others experience spiritual transformation and union with god

in examining henri nouwen's approach to the ministry of soul care and spiritual formation at close range we can conclude that his holistic and integrative style is essentially drawn from his sophisticated understanding of the coinherence of spirituality with psychology ministry and theology henri nouwen's ministry is characterized by a ministry of integration primarily because he first of all embodied a spirituality of integration his ministry was but an overflow of his spirituality unquestionably nouwen ministered out of who he was as a person a person of deep integrity the author contends that henri nouwen's work of soul care and spiritual formation is never about techniques neither is it about programs and curricula important as they are in ministry more importantly it is definitely not about roles even though multiple roles have been attached to his person

spirituality has an indispensable role to play in the expression of our humanity however spiritual practices can sometimes make us less not more authentically human we may be good christians but we aren't good human beings how can we ensure that our

spiritual journey is conducted in a way that allows us to become fully alive and deeply human david benner has spent thirty five years integrating psychology and spirituality here he presents an expansive psychologically informed understanding of spirituality probing the contrasts between soulful and soulless spirituality deep and shallow religion and healthy and unhealthy relationships with god to affirm the vital role of human development in the spiritual journey benner then suggests soulful practices for cultivating the christian spiritual life this book will appeal to readers seeking depth and substance in their quest for authentic spirituality it will also be a helpful resource for mental health professionals and spiritual directors reflection questions and exercises for individual or group use are included at the end of each chapter d

many people in christian ministry are tired of simplistic certainties what they need is permission to live with uncertainty with mystery ambiguity and paradox because we live in a world that is far removed from the modernist version of reality with its rational clinical and superficial presentation of life we need the courage and wisdom to embrace the presence of uncertainties in the midst of certainty in this book the author offers snapshots of a number of central christian topics god the gospel the church salvation ministry inviting us to treat them as features of a landscape to explore rather than a set of propositional statements to sign up to each chapter short enough to provoke interest and curiosity will be a catalyst for deeper reflection and enquiry inviting us to discover a new freedom in ministry as we embrace a more generous both and perspective in place of a more narrow either or interpretation of the christian faith in the process we may find ourselves rediscovering the life we have lost in living as we imaginatively participate in the life ministry and mystery of the triune god of grace in our midst

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
