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china s rapid economic development in recent decades has significantly boosted its international political activities as evidenced by the promotion of a set of relevant global foreign policy doctrines unlike the concepts adopted under mao zedong and deng xiaoping which were primarily ideological china s foreign policy conceptions since the early 2000s have been more scientific and commercial the book analyses factors that influenced the change of foreign policy discourse of china during xi jinping s premiership from 2012 till now the book analyses the genesis and contents of modern china s major foreign policy conceptions such as the one belt one road initiative these conceptions will be examined through the methodology of different theories and approaches from sinicized marxism max weber s theory through to foucault derrida and others an important and challenging issue in china s modern discourse is the problem of democracy and human rights the book takes an interdisciplinary to these problems in relations between the west and china modern china having carried out rapid socio economic scientific and technological development not only did not change its political system but also proceeded to reformat the international sphere of human rights in accordance with its understanding of them the growing shutdown of china to the outside world narrows the opportunities for researchers in whose arsenal the analysis of the discourse of key foreign policy actors occupies one of the central places

the shanghai cooperation organization sco is the first and most established regional organization initiated by china this book investigates china s use of the sco to shape global norms and argues that self created regional organizations constitute ideal platforms for emerging powers to promote their normative views internationally based on original chinese language documents and interviews the book illustrates how china has used the sco as a regional platform that both represents and promotes china s core normative views and concepts internationally the analysis offers crucial insights into the chinese government s ambitions for norms and rules of contemporary international relations

this book showcases how the people s republic of china prc has been utilizing the belt and road initiative bri to reshape the global order dissecting china s increasingly assertive international behaviour the book demonstrates how the prc projects its self perception onto the international order the book outlines five aspects of china s international role projection which the prc applies selectively depending on its target

audience 1 the bearer of traditional chinese culture 2 the humiliated nation 3 the socialist state with chinese characteristics 4 the developing state and promoter of international development 5 the authoritarian globalization optimist drawing on an in depth analysis of hundreds of primary bri documents the book offers a comprehensive overview of china s most crucial foreign policy agenda item it demonstrates how through the bri the prc has introduced mechanisms to the international level which reflect its domestic policy making mode in addition the prc has institutionalized the initiative by establishing china centered bri networks across a wide range of policy areas within those emerging china centered bri networks the prc systematically increases its international discursive power for example by inserting chinese vocabulary into un resolutions or by promoting beijing s approaches vis à vis the rule of law across a range of developing states this book also further discusses the implications of the bri for the international legal order

in the long game rush doshi demonstrates that china is in fact playing a long methodical game to replace america as a global hegemon drawing from a rich base of chinese primary sources including decades worth of party documents and memoirs by party leaders he traces the basic evolution of chinese strategy showing how it evolved in response to changes in us policy and the us s position in the world order

this volume offers the essential theoretical thought of the austro marxist thinkers otto bauer max adler karl renner friedrich adler rudolf hilferding and otto neurath over the span of their austrian social democratic careers from the decades before world war i until the mid 1930s austro marxist theoretical perspectives were conceived as social scientific tools for the issues that faced the development of socialism in their time the relevance of their thought for the contemporary world inheres in this understanding

combining insights from comparative legal theory jurisprudence and legal history this collection examines the legal and constitutional identity of central and eastern europe although the various countries of central and eastern europe have often compared themselves to the west the failure of these countries to engage with one another has resulted in a whole spectrum of legal identities remaining hidden this book takes up a comparison of such identities within the region of central and eastern europe and following from the prima facie similarity between the region s countries given the experience of communism and legal transfers the book thereby illuminates through comparisons the distinct legal identities of the 16 central and eastern european states whilst at the same time arguing for a shared central and eastern european legal identity this book will appeal to scholars and students in the

area of comparative law as well as lawyers political scientists sociologists and historians with particular interests in central and eastern europe

in the aftermath of world war two approximately three million sudeten germans were expelled from their homes in the former czechoslovakia because of their part in the dismemberment of the czechoslovak republic by nazi germany in 1938 39 for many years their representatives the sudeten german association attempted in vain to redress the wrong done to their people however the end of the cold war has given a new impetus to their campaign currently they attempt to block czech entry into the eu unless there is restitution of confiscated properties jürgen tampke tells the story of the sudeten germans from the beginning of their settlement seven hundred years ago in what is now the czech republic to current times

would you want to be operated on by a surgeon trained at a medical school that did not evaluate its students would you want to fly in a plane designed by people convinced that the laws of physics are socially constructed would you want to be tried by a legal system indifferent to the distinction between fact and fiction these questions may seem absurd but these are theories being seriously advanced by radical multiculturalists that force us to ask them these scholars assert that such concepts as truth and merit are inextricably racist and sexist that reason and objectivity are merely sophisticated masks for ideological bias and that reality itself is nothing more than a socially constructed mechanism for preserving the power of the ruling elite in beyond all reason liberal legal scholars daniel a farber and suzanna sherry mount the first systematic critique of radical multiculturalism as a form of legal scholarship beginning with an incisive overview of the origins and basic tenets of radical multiculturalism the authors critically examine the work of derrick bell catherine mackinnon patricia williams and richard delgado and explore the alarming implications of their theories farber and sherry push these theories to their logical conclusions and show that radical multiculturalism is destructive of the very goals it wishes to affirm if for example the concept of advancement based on merit is fraudulent as the multiculturalists claim the disproportionate success of jews and asians in our culture becomes difficult to explain without opening the door to age old anti semitic and racist stereotypes if historical and scientific truths are entirely relative social constructs then holocaust denial becomes merely a matter of perspective and creationism has as much validity as evolution the authors go on to show that rather than promoting more dialogue the radical multiculturalist

preferences for legal storytelling and identity politics over reasoned argument produces an insular set of positions that resist open debate indeed radical multiculturalists cannot critically examine each others ideas without incurring vehement accusations of racism and sexism much less engage in fruitful discussion with a mainstream that does not share their assumptions here again farber and sherry show that the end result of such thinking is not freedom but a kind of totalitarianism where dissent cannot be tolerated and only the naked will to power remains to settle differences sharply written and brilliantly argued this book is itself a model of the kind of clarity civility and dispassionate critical thinking which the authors seek to preserve from the attacks of the radical multiculturalists with far reaching implications for such issues as government control of hate speech and pornography affirmative action legal reform and the fate of all minorities beyond all reason is a provocative contribution to one of the most important controversies of our time
