prices established by the workings of the market are fundamentally just he allows considerable moral latitude to the pursuit of profit which he regards as spiritually dangerous but not necessarily evil through the lens of their opposing views on economic value the market price and what does or does not constitute the sin of usury the authors with astonishing technical acumen observe analyze and pass moral judgment on a remarkably wide range of complex transactions most of which have counterparts in twenty first century financial markets in the process they tackle problems that still bedevil economists and accountants in our own day such as the difference between a sale and a borrowing the just value of future income flows and the presence of asymmetrical information in pricing the result is a vivid record of the color and texture of early modern economic life that reveals a surprising degree of financial sophistication that the present book makes accessible to the modern reader
