modern jesuit teachers and humanists associated rhetoric with a civic function jesuit writings not only on rhetoric but also on moral religious and political themes testify to their thorough familiarity with cicero s civic philosophy following cicero isocrates and renaissance humanists early modern jesuit teachers of the studia humanitatis coupled eloquence with wisdom and in so doing invested the rhetorician with such qualities and duties which many quattrocento humanists ascribed to an active citizen or statesman these qualities centred on the duty to promote the common good by actively participating in civic life this book will appeal to scholars and students alike interested in the history of the jesuits history of ideas and early modern history in general
