V Example Applying Stoichiometry Lets consider a stoichiometry problem The textbook will provide examples using balanced equations and mole calculations A common pitfall is incorrect mole ratio calculations For example consider the reaction  $2\text{H}_2 + \text{O}_2 \rightarrow 2\text{H}_2\text{O}$  To find the moles of water produced from 3 moles of hydrogen you need to use the mole ratio 2 moles  $\text{H}_2$  : 2 moles  $\text{H}_2\text{O}$  3 moles  $\text{H}_2$  : 3 moles  $\text{H}_2\text{O}$  Failing to use the correct mole ratio from the balanced equation is a frequent mistake
