r j berry writes as a professional biologist and as a christian believer he contends that the interplay of science and faith requires continual re examination in the light of scientific developments with the consequent need to review religious assumptions to quote from his preface where science and faith meet they must be congruent if they are not both the science and the religion ought to be examined religion cannot drive the content of science nor can science properly determine the nature of religion r j berry's treatment differs from traditional work in science and religion in that he intentionally and explicitly extends his exploration of the implications of religious faith for contemporary science to environmental conservation or creation care professor berry's expertise in this area is
