preparing for an audition and unsure of what you want to do the ultimate scene and monologue sourcebook is the book you've been waiting for unlike scene books that reprint 50 to 75 monologues excerpted from plays but don't include any background information this annotated guide tells you what you really need to know about audition material from more than 300 contemporary plays here is how the book works suppose that you're looking for a dramatic male/female scene when you scan part one play synopses and analyses you come across an entry for *The Middle of the Night* by Paddy Chayefsky this is what you see

The Middle of the Night by Paddy Chayefsky Samuel French synopsis A kindly 53-year-old widower falls in love with a 23-year-old woman who is unhappily married to a musician no one in their circle of acquaintances approves of this union but their love is true analysis excellent human drama frequently touching actors who play the widower need to have a good feel for New York City/Brooklyn speech patterns this sensitivity isn't as essential for the part of the woman all levels scenes monologues male monologues 1 female female scenes 1 male female scenes 2 in addition to basic information about the play author and publisher the entry provides you with the story line a critique of the play and the number of audition-worthy monologues and scenes it contains if the description of this particular play piques your interest your next step is to turn to part six male/female scenes for specifics about the selection this is what you'll see there

The Middle of the Night by Paddy Chayefsky Samuel French drama act II scene 2 pp 40-44 the manufacturer 53 and the 23 after an unsatisfactory attempt at lovemaking the manufacturer feels awful that he wasn't able to perform usually he is very understanding he then asks her to marry him the actor playing the manufacturer must have a good feel for regional New York speech patterns this skill is less critical for the actress playing the start the manufacturer I'm sorry Betty end the manufacturer Oh my sweet I love you so much you don't know if you change your mind tomorrow I won't be angry with you I won't lie to you Betty I'm afraid this entry tells you what type of scene this is dramatic where you'll find the selection act scene and page numbers the length of the scene the names and ages of the characters the context in which the characters are speaking and the first and last lines of the scene if the material seems appropriate all you have to do is get a copy of the play and get to work because the ultimate scene and monologue sourcebook enables you to make informed decisions about the suitability of more than 1,000 monologues and scenes which you can find easily through the book's extensive cross indexes you'll gain a critical edge in the auditioning process

Lexx unauthorized series 4 the little blue marble the final chapter in the saga of Lexx and its crew Kai an undead assassin Zev a combination of love slave and cluster lizard Stanley Tweedle a hapless security guard and 790 a robot head careening through space together a stolen planet destroying biological warship shaped like a dragonfly the fourth series came

along at the 11th hour with a last minute purchase by the us sci fi channel the fourth series once again sees a radical reinvention of the show and a season of more episodes than ever before for less money the lexx having destroyed heaven and hell finds another planet on the opposite side of the sun earth a world which they can't seem to get away from as they encounter divine executioners mummies militias porn stars prisons druids cowboys mad scientists morticians and the most bizarre elements of american society lexx was one of the strangest most surreal series ever conceived owing as much to barbarella and bunuel as to star trek and star wars it was unique and unforgettable mixing black comedy and absurdism with epic drama and an astonishing visual sense backstage the story of the creation of the series was even more extraordinary a tale of regional atlantic film makers renegade artists cult film makers wild experimentation canadian cultural nationalism german entrepreneurs new computer generated imagery technologies and backstage chaos intersecting in wildly unpredictable ways to create truly exotic images and stories the product of years of research and dozens of interviews this is a must buy for any fan of the show itself or of science fiction movies television generally and an eye opening insight into film and television production especially canadian and international productions the fourth chapter follows the frantic history of a production pushing the outer limits of possibility and the decline and fall of the production company salter street that birthed it

screen writing is a unique literary form screenplays are like musical scores in that they are intended to be interpreted on the basis of other artists performances rather than serving as finished products for the enjoyment of their readers they are written using technical jargon and tight spare prose to describe set directions unlike a novella a script focuses on describing the literal visual aspects of the story rather than on its characters internal thoughts in screen writing the aim is to evoke those thoughts and emotions through subtext action and symbolism prominent hollywood script doctors include steve zaillian william goldman robert townes mort nathan quentin tarantino etc while many up and coming screenwriters work as ghost writers this book is a modest catalogue of some of the most prominent screenwriters listed from a to z the good are sometimes bad and they can be even ugly many comments herein included were googled in deference to the multiplicity of information available today yet they reflect exactly or almost what i thought an amazing thing today is how anonymous commentators on the internet rival and even surpass the poor quality of professional media and specialised literature it all comes down to watching the truth 24 times per second to quote jean luc godard's phrase not to mention that such truth may include sex scenes violence pedophilia etc we know that a literary masterpiece like henry james portrait of a lady became a film of very poor quality as scripted by laura jones we know conversely that a mediocre writer like mickey spillane inspired at least one film as remarkable as kiss me deadly thanks to a i bezzerides script asa former screenwriter

mr correa must avow that he found the job most gratifying writing that looks effortless is often hellish to write and revise it was something he did have to slog through but it proved particularly pleasing editing discussing finishing your work is particularly gratifying identifying your flaws and working to mitigate them is also gratifying it is a general perception that creative careers are more interesting and fun than others but the privilege of earning money through imagination and creativity is effectively hard won please comment at will please disagree at will be facetious in your remarks but please be neither vicious nor mean spirited

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
