wicked accuracy and ultimately surprisingly rather moving it plunges straight to the heart of the endless convolutions of sexual mores and does so with acrobatic wit guardian owners i was in an old woman s flat when a young man offering her money to move came round that was one of the starting points of the play caryl churchill the plays in this volume represent the best of churchill s writing up to and including her emergence onto the international theatre scene with cloud nine
