- Hepatocellular Carcinoma HCC** Most common type originating from liver cells
- Cholangiocarcinoma** Cancer of the bile ducts within the liver

NonAlcoholic Fatty Liver Disease NAFLD Excess fat accumulation in the liver not caused by alcohol abuse

NonAlcoholic Steatohepatitis NASH More severe form of NAFLD with liver inflammation and potential progression to cirrhosis
