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excerpt from first year mathematics for secondary schools the course of study in american high schools is in process of extensive change the change commenced with the introduction of new subjects at first science began to compete with the older subjects then came manual training commercial and agricultural subjects the fine arts and a whole series of new literary courses in the beginning the traditional subjects saw no reason for mixing in this forward movement and such phrases as regular studies substantial subjects and serious courses were frequently heard as evidences of the complacent satisfaction with which the well established departments viewed the struggles for place of the newer subjects today
