Although the case processing system generally treated offenders similarly, there were racial differences at two key points: minority suspects were more likely than whites to be released after arrest; however, after a felony conviction, minority

offenders were more likely than whites to be given longer sentences and to be put in prison instead of jail there were no statistically significant differences that implied discrimination against minorities in corrections
