threedimensionality of your drawing

III Mastering TwoPoint and ThreePoint Perspective

Twopoint perspective adds complexity by introducing a second vanishing point allowing for the depiction of corners and objects viewed from an angle Threepoint perspective introduces a third vanishing point either above or below the horizon useful for dramatically foreshortened views

TwoPoint Example Drawing a building viewed from a street corner requires two vanishing points one on each side of the drawing

ThreePoint Example Drawing a cityscape from a low vantage point requires a third vanishing point above the horizon creating a strong sense of looking upwards Conversely a view from a high vantage point needs a vanishing point below the horizon

Light Construction Start with light lines easily erasable Avoid pressing too hard initially

Accurate Measurements Use a ruler to ensure accuracy especially when establishing orthogonal lines
