13 Defenses in Criminal Law Defenses are legal arguments that aim to negate the prosecutions case preventing a conviction Common defenses include **Insanity** A legal defense arguing the accused lacked the mental capacity to understand the wrongfulness of their actions **SelfDefense** A defense claiming the accused acted in reasonable defense of themselves or another person **Entrapment** A defense arguing the accused was induced by law enforcement to commit the crime Example A defendant claiming selfdefense in a stabbing case would need to prove they reasonably believed they were in imminent danger and had no other option to escape
