indications of human sacrifice and violent death not only supports this view but reveals how ritual practices developed over time the seemingly sudden demise of shellfish consumption clausen contends was not due to overharvesting and environmental change it ended rather because the sacred rituals changed feasting with shellfish in the southern ohio valley is a work bound to stir controversy and debate among scholars of the archaic period just as surely it will encourage a new appreciation for the spiritual life of ancient peoples how they thought about the cosmos and the mysterious forces that surrounded them
