by Baloo the brown bear of the ways of the jungle he is protected by Bagheera the black panther who finds this task difficult when the tiger Shere Khan returns to the jungle he demands the man cub be given to him as it was he who killed Mowgli's parents Mowgli then must find a way to save himself from the murderous tiger and discover where he truly belongs jungle or man village the remainder of the book is made up of other tales depicting the struggles surrounding animals coexisting with people
