until 1832 when an act of parliament began to regulate the use of bodies for anatomy in Britain public dissection was regularly and legally carried out on the bodies of murderers and a shortage of cadavers gave rise to the infamous murders committed by Burke and Hare to supply dissection subjects to Dr Robert Knox the anatomist this book tells the scandalous story of how medical men obtained the corpses upon which they worked before the use of human remains was regulated Helen MacDonald looks particularly at the activities of British surgeons in nineteenth century Van Diemen's Land and

penal colony in which a ready supply of bodies was available not only convicted murderers but also aborigines and the unfortunate poor who died in hospitals were routinely turned over to the surgeons this sensitive but searing account shows how abuses happen even within the conventions adopted by civilized societies it reveals how from burke and hare to today's televised dissections by german anatomist dr gunther von hagens some people's bodies become other people's entertainment

in the early nineteenth century body snatching was rife because the only corpses available for medical study were those of hanged murderers with the anatomy act of 1832 however the bodies of those who died destitute in workhouses were appropriated for dissection at a time when such a procedure was regarded with fear and revulsion the anatomy act effectively rendered dissection a punishment for poverty providing both historical and contemporary insights death dissection and the destitute opens rich new prospects in history and history of science the new afterword draws important parallels between social and medical history and contemporary concerns regarding organs for transplant and human tissue for research

why did medical men of the european middle ages and renaissance make it a central point of medical education to cut the bodies of condemned criminals into their smallest parts and perform experiments on vivisected animals neither had any direct medical relevance and the purpose of this book is to discover what lay at the basis of these practices what purpose they served and what cultural circumstances made them possible and desirable the book offers a series of answers based on the religious intellectual and social circumstances that were particularly european beliefs about the body and soul the compartmentalised nature of late medieval academic and intellectual life the economic pressures and market forces that governed the trade of medicine and the specialty of anatomy are all examined the illustrations generated by these circumstances and by the arts of the woodcut and of printing are given special attention

excerpt from demonstrations of anatomy being a guide to the dissection of the human body anatomy may be studied in two different methods the one demonstrative and the other descriptive the former treats of the parts only as they are exposed in dissection and of their relative position the latter gives minute details of objects unseen describing the different structures without reference to the order in which they appear and has been very generally employed in the numerous works of instruction in practical anatomy but every one acquainted with the difficulties to be overcome by the young dissector will readily admit that this method is insufficient as a guide to his progress to supply this deficiency the present work designed and completed from the subject and confirmed by experience is humbly submitted to the student in the hope that his labours will be diminished and the advantages to be gained in the pursuit of practical knowledge increased in the execution of the plan the great divisions of the body which are generally established viz head and neck thorax back extremities and abdomen have been placed in different sections and the dissection of each has been conducted by the employment of successive stages determined either by certain apparently natural limits or by those most convenient in
