paul s letter to the romans has been called the quintessence and perfection of saving doctrine perhaps the most challenging and thoroughly doctrinal book of the entire new

whole of the pauline corpus and then by interpreting rom 11 26 and gal 6 16 with a larger understanding of identity in paul at hand

this book argues that paul s seminal thesis on human moral formation in romans 12 1 2 can be best understood when it is interpreted through the lens of a philosophical and theological anthropology that merges the views of thomas aquinas and james k a smith

in his epistles paul at various points uses maternal imagery to talk about his apostolic labors sometimes actually referring to himself as a mother for example paul writes that he must behave like a nurse caring for her own children later he writes he is in labor again and must continue to nurse his fellow christians with milk these images though known among earlier generations of christians today remain largely both unacknowledged and unexplored in thinking about paul and his work in our mother saint paul beverly gaventa retrieves these images explores their significance for understanding apostolic ministry and demonstrates how they point beyond their original contexts and offer unique perspectives for understanding paul s thought as well as the larger cosmic understanding of the gospel

the phrase works of the law occurs only in the dead sea scrolls and in paul but it has a different connotation in each corpus at qumran the works of the law are deeds of obedience to god s law and are ultimately inspired by god they function as a means of atonement whether for the individual who performs them or for the sins of others for paul on the other hand the works of the law are quintessentially the works of abraham though they are indeed good deeds abraham himself was a sinful man and so his deeds could not make atonement for himself or for others in fact paul is reacting against the idea of

abraham as a redeemer figure that was held by some of his contemporaries the phrase works of the law thus takes on a negative coloration in paul as a deceptively false means of salvation against qumran paul's position is that justification must be effected apart from works of the law and thus by jesus christ abraham is no second adam as some were thinking and his good deeds epitomized in his sacrifice of isaac had no atoning value this closely reasoned study makes an important contribution to the study of new testament theology it undertakes to settle some long standing debates about paul's soteriology by proposing an alternative both to traditional interpretation of paul and to the new perspective on paul
