the antebellum period has long been identified with the belated emergence of a truly national literature and yet as meredith I megill argues a mass market for books in this period was built and sustained through what we would call rampant literary piracy a national literature developed not despite but because of the systematic copying of foreign works restoring a political dimension to accounts of the economic grounds of antebellum literature megill unfolds the legal arguments and political struggles that produced an american culture of reprinting and held it in place for two crucial decades in this culture of reprinting the circulation of print outstripped authorial and editorial control
