Hypothesis Testing After estimating a regression model we need to test the significance of our findings Hypothesis testing allows us to determine whether the estimated coefficients are statistically different from zero implying a genuine relationship between variables We use p-values and confidence intervals to assess this For example a low p-value eg 0.05 suggests that the effect of an independent variable is statistically significant

Model Specification Choosing the right variables and functional form for your regression is crucial Incorrect specification can lead to biased and inconsistent estimates For
