this book defends a new interpretation of hegel s theoretical
philosophy according to which it has a single organizing focus giving
philosophical force to his arguments in his central science of logic
and undercutting prominent worries the focus is not epistemology or
skepticism but the metaphysics of reason in the world

of all the topics in the history of philosophy the history of
different forms of thinking and contemplation is one of the most
